We therefore demand that the University of Hawai'i:

- 1. Refuse to allow military recruitment (including FBI & CIA) on campus.
- 2. Refuse to be enforcers for the wartime police state¹.
- 3. Oppose SEVIS² and protect the rights of international students.
- 4. Publish a single, easily accessible list of <u>all</u> military-funded grants and projects at UH, including those funded through UH-affiliated research foundations or corporations.
- 5. Provide a "permanent" space, in a centrally located area on campus, where students can speak out on the war through art and written word.
