EBA PROGRESS TO REPORT BACK SESSIONS

Unions met with council to continue negotiations on the 28th September 2004. As negotiations progress the issue of a wage increase has finally come to the table. Council provided a response to the ASU claim for 7% per annum increase to wages. The unions based their claim on the increase to cost of living, and comparing HBCC rates of pay with other councils.

Wage offer

• Councils first offer

Council proposed as their first initial response: (5% - Year 1, 3% - Year 2, 2.5% - Year 3)

The unions rejected this offer. The unions were open to councils year 1 payment of 5% in recognition that would bring employees up to a more reasonable rate of pay, however year 2 and 3 reduces this step forward reducing the amount over three years to be a 3.5% per annum payment.

The union responded with a counter offer that members may consider as reasonable to progress with negotiations: FEDERAL (Union offer 5% - Year 1, 4% - Year 2 and 4% - Year 3).

• Councils second offer

Council has considered the offer put forward by you on behalf of its employees and responds as follows:-

FEDERAL (Union offer 5%, 4% and 4%)

In response Council offers 5%, 3.5% and 3% (Inclusive of any SNA) with the following amendment –

That all loading for new permanent part time employees be removed. That the ceiling of 10% of total workforce for permanent part time be increased to 20% and that permanent part time employees will receive overtime penalty rates once they have worked in excess of a standard fortnight hours (eg 72.5hrs). Any hours worked within normal fortnightly hours will be paid at the normal hourly rate.

The proposed EBA is also include statements with regard to Transmission of Business, Employment Security and Healthy Staff Program, subject to IR requirements in relation to the Electrolux Decision.

These offers are made without prejudice and require official endorsement by Council. It is expected that Council will consider the EBA and wage increases proposed at its meeting of 13 October.
