

## What is the World Social Forum??

The Perth Social Forum follows the inspiring World Social Forums which have taken place over the last four years.

"The World Social Forum is an open meeting place for reflective thinking, democratic debate of ideas, formulation of proposals, free exchange of experiences and interlinking for effective action, by groups and movements of civil society that are opposed to neoliberalism and to the domination of the world by capital and any form of imperialism, and are committed to building a planetary society directed towards fruitful relationships among Humankind and between it and the Earth."

- (5) The World Social Forum was created to provide an open platform to discuss strategies of resistance to the process of neo-liberal globalisation formulated at the annual World Economic Forum by the IMF, the World Bank, the WTO and carried on by the large multinational corporations with the complicity of national governments (Art. 4).
- The World Social Forum seeks to provide a space for discussing alternatives and for strengthening alliances between individuals, social movements, union and non-government organisations engaged in concrete actions.
- © The World Social Forum is an ongoing process of cooperation amongst individuals and groups from the local level to the national level and seeking active participation in the international context (Art. 14).
- (6) The World Social Forum condemns every war, all forms of domination and the use of violence as a means of social control by the state (Art. 10).
- © The World Social Forum is a movement of non-violent social resistance, made by the active participation of people, practicing democracy from below and building a new world in solidarity (Art. 13-14).

### What the PERTH SOCIAL FORUM

#### could be ...

- © a space created for and by the participants, to promote discussion in a spirit of openness, collaboration and constructive debate.
- (a) a space for music, art, activism, debate, connection, and revitalisation.
- © a platform for groups and individuals to make proposals for action and to make concrete inter-linkages between campaigns.
- an open space promoting solidarity and cooperation among the diversity of social change networks in Perth, Australia and

internationally.


- Organise a workshop for the Perth Social Forum. Get your proposals in soon or contact us to discuss your ideas.
