10 Years of Leadership in Development of Internet & It's Applications to Higher Education in Asia
**Keio School of Internet Asia Project (SOI Asia):
10th Anniversary Symposium**

*Opportunities for Journalists to Interview over the Satellite Internet Connection Between Tokyo - Indonesia

Prof. Jun Murai, Professor of Faculty of Environmental Information at Keio University led Widely Integrated Distributed Environment (WIDE) Project to contribute to development of the Internet infrastructure and the higher education in Asia by starting the two leading projects, namely, Asian Internet Interconnection Initiative (AI3) Project to develop the Internet technologies and their applications for the advanced usage of the Internet and School of Internet Asia (SOI Asia). SOI Asia constructed distance learning systems utilizing AI3's internet infrastructure which delivered live Internet lectures to 24 universities and research institutions in 13 Asian countries. This initiative has successfully resulted in developing human resources in the IT technology field in the Asian partner countries. A Commemorative Symposium will be held to celebrate the 10th Anniversary of AI3 at the Institute of Technology, Bandung, Indonesia on Wednesday, October 11. The Minister for Research & Technology and Director General of Higher Education, Ministry of National Education, Republic of Indonesia will be present at the event which be broadcasted live at the Tokyo Campus of Keio University through the SOI Asia remote system environment.

1. SOI Asia has constructed a network with unprecedented dimension and diversity of 24 partner institutions in 13 South East Asian countries including Myanmar and Laos.
2. SOI Asia's 10 years of development and deployment of Internet infrastructure in Asia can well be described as the history of the Asian IT infrastructure development, looking back to the start of the project when Internet itself was yet very rare.
3. As a result of a successful rearing of Asian IT human resource and network through SOI Asia, these engineers and technical staff now play the key roles of the IT developments and usages in each countries..
4. SOI Asia was among the first to support Syiah Kuala University which suffered a devastating damage of losing more than 100 faculty members by the Tsunami disaster off Sumatra. Their university function was quickly recovered utilizing the distance learning system of SOI Asia.
