

Creative Commons has come to Hong Kong!

Creative Commons (CC) is a copyright licence that defines the spectrum of possibilities between full copyright (all rights reserved) and the public domain (no rights reserved). Our licences help you keep your copyright while inviting certain uses of your work. In other words, it is a "some rights reserved" approach to copyright.

Professor Lawrence Lessig is the world's foremost authority on copyright and intellectual property issues, a visionary seeking to reconcile creative freedom with marketplace competition. A leading authority on cyber law, he has focused his scholarship on the problem of how law should govern the exchange of information and ideas in the digital age. He is also a strong advocate of social institutions that can help to unleash creative impulses at all levels of society.

Professor Lessig is the founder and co-director of Stanford law school's Center for Internet and Society, founder of the Creative Commons project, and a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.

Snoblind (Vincent and Regina) are one of the few local musical ensembles actually practicing CC music. Their live performances in Hong Kong received raving response and has been invited to perform in Taiwan by the CC community there as the face of Hong Kong's CC music. Their debut CD "Musica Di Digitalia" was released in May 2006.

The duo will perform live at the CCHK launch, and Snoblind will explain the role of CC in broadening their creativity in composing.

The translation is published in both traditional and simplified characters format. OOPS will present an overview of OpenCourseWare and Open Education Resources, the development of Chinese translation projects and an appeal to educaators in Hong Kong to open up the wealth of education resources.

Creative Commons Hong Kong (CCHK) works with Creative Commons International to localize and promote the use of Creative Commons licenses in Hong Kong.

We support the development and promotion of free tools that enable people to easily mark their creative work so that it can be shared legally by others.

Our goal is to serve Hong Kong's diverse creative talents and enhance the development of intellectual industries in Hong Kong.

By promoting CC through education, advocacy, technical support, and community participation, we aim to educate Hong Kong citizens about copyright law more broadly, as one legal option that coexists alongside other options.

Citizen journalists or photographers, artists or DJs, teachers, students or animation fans - everyone can use CC to legally share and enjoy the creations of fellow Hong Kong citizens.

We believe that widespread use of CC can help to enhance respect for all forms of copyright. We also believe that nourishing free culture and legal sharing can greatly enhance our educational environment, as well as boost Hong Kong's capacity for innovation and creativity.

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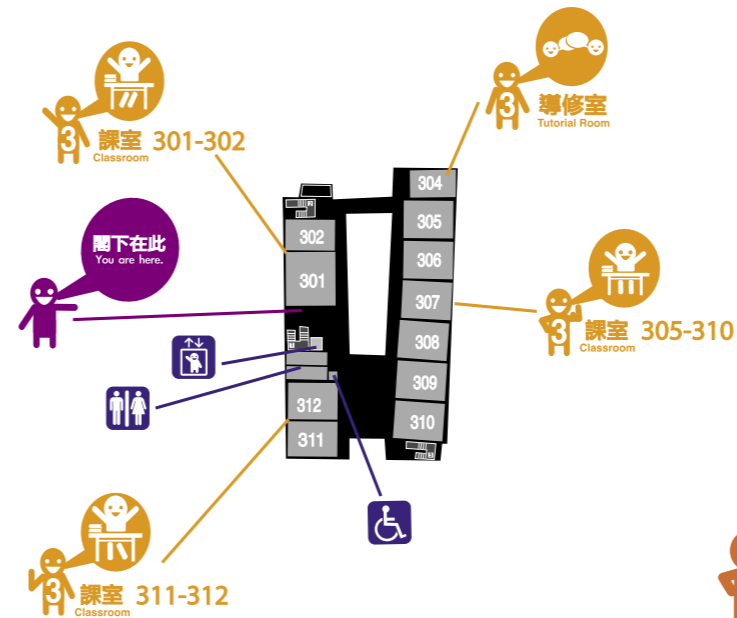
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
