
#### THE ROCKEFELLER MYSTERY

#### FRIDAY, JANUARY 21

Before boarding his plane in Newcastle to return to Melbourne, Mr Rockefeller rings his wife. Victoria.

Mrs Rockefeller, who is at the Australian Open, misses the call and he leaves a message for her about when he'll be home that night.

9PM: Mr Rockefeller walks through Melbourne Airport to the long-term car park carrying his luggage, including a laptop and grapefruit. His phone is not activated after the flight.

11PM - MIDNIGHT: Mrs Rockefeller rings Stonnington police to report her husband missing.

#### **SUNDAY, JANUARY 24**

Mrs Rockefeller and her brother-in-law Robert Rockefeller hold a press conference pleading for information about the whereabouts of Herman.

#### MONDAY, JANUARY 25

The homicide squad joins the investigation. Shortly before midday Mr Rockefeller's blue Toyota Prius is seen in a laneway in Ballan, near the Werribee River.

#### TUESDAY. JANUARY 26

HADFIELD PROPERTY

Sightings of Mr Rockefeller are reported to police. Gordon General Store owners John and Jan Spiteri tell police he walked into their shop twice during the previous

The MFB is called out to a fire at a Glenroy property, where Mr Rockefeller's remains are

#### **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 27**

Investigators searching for Mr Rockefeller access his Facebook page and ask questions of those wanting to be his "friend". The site swells from one South African business associate to 21 "friend" in a day.

#### THURSDAY, JANUARY 28

Victoria Police execute a warrant on a Hadfield property in South St, arresting a man and a woman in relation to his disappearance. Grave fears are held for Mr Rockefeller's safety.

### FRIDAY, JANUARY 29

Police separate two people being held in custody, a man aged 57 and a woman, 41. Detectives and the police air wing conduct searches in central Victoria, particularly around Heathcote.

An exclusion zone is set up in bushland off Forest Drive about 4pm.
