 Better protection for workers taking part in lawful industrial action – so that all workers have the right to take official industrial action free from the fear of dismissal or victimisation.
2. Preventing the use of agency workers to replace striking workers - to tighten loopholes in the existing law and improve compliance
3. Fairer balloting procedures – cutting the "red tape" that unions face when balloting members for industrial action by placing a duty on employers to supply trade unions with information they need to comply with notice and balloting requirements.
