#### PLEASE MAKE 3 SELECTIONS IN ORDER OF PREFERENCE FROM THESE WORKSHOPS

#### 1. Occupational Health and Safety and the Act and Regulations

The purpose of this workshop is to provide activists with a working knowledge of how the Act and Regulations apply. The workshop will also address how committees are intended to work, their responsibilities and the individual's role as a union member.

#### 2. Effective OH&S Working Committees

Want to learn how to make your Occupational Health and Safety Committee more effective? This course is designed for those workers who have experience working on OH&S Committees. If you have not taken previous courses on the OH&S Act and Regulations this workshop is **not** for you.

#### 3. <u>Harassment Investigation in the Workplace</u>

An in-depth examination of harassment investigation in the workplace. An advanced harassment workshop dealing with the tools and procedures for dealing with allegations of harassment and completing an investigation.

#### 4. <u>Workers' Compensation</u>

This workshop will review the Workers' Compensation Act and Review process. It will communicate and promote an understanding of workers' compensation and provide oral and written information on how to apply, appeal, use and complete forms, etc. We will look at the current trends in Workers' Compensation, new developments in the system (return to work/early intervention). We will examine how these changes impact/benefit workers.

#### 5. <u>Duty to Accommodate</u>

This workshop will examine how disabled workers are brought back to the workplace. What is the duty of employers, unions and employees? What considerations must be provided to workers.

#### 6. <u>Why Does My Work Hurt??</u>

Does it hurt at work? Is your job causing your body to ache? This workshop will help identify why and help you to find ways to make work a little less painful. We will provide tools to identify and understand why our bodies, and in some cases, minds are causing us to hurt at work.

#### 7. <u>Blame the Worker</u>

An opportunity to identify the occupational health and safety trends in the workplace that focuses on targeting the workers rather than solving problems.

#### 8. <u>The Corruption of Health and Safety in Canada</u>

Learn how the Internal Responsibility System (IRS) has gradually stripped workers of their input into OH&S matters and is putting OH&S responsibilities back into the hands of varied experts and professionals who want to control OH&S objectives and enforcement.

#### 9. <u>Violence in the Workplace</u>

In 1993 legislation was introduced in to the Occupational Health and Safety Act protecting workers from violence in the workplace. In 2010 it appears that workplace violence, intimidation and bullying is on the increase. What went wrong? What should we do?
