Keep It Simple, Stupid!

Your promo photos look best if you keep K.I.S.S in mind

No disturbing backgrounds, but focus on the artist or the band.



HOW TO Rock your promo photos

Make sure the artist is comfortable.

It's an essential starting point for both promo shoots and live performances.

Get great shots @ live shows

At a live performance, I am always looking for that particular shot no one else has. How to get such a unique shot?

I always try to capture the moment, something special that's happening on stage or something that happens in the audience. Trying to shoot the atmosphere often turns out well if you play with lightning.

In the end it's always about right timing, of course. This is rather easy when you are photographing a rock band, but much harder to capture when you are photographing a singer/songwriter.

Using different locations, and differnt angles/lenses will sure help you to get that one particular image.

I always try to be close to the artist, use a wide angle and try to come as close as a few inches.. In this way your image will be more alive and you create the concert feeling in your photos.

The next photo does create that feeling.

Also, try to capture the emotion! I have my finger on the shutter button all the time, waiting for that one special picture.

Never be satisfied with a few great shots!



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

Pay attention to all the details on stage, there is so much to shoot!

Often an artist or band repeats a certain pattern, because their experience is that the audience likes it.

Anticipate on this to get great shots!

Make sure you minimize the use of flash! It will annoy the audience and the artist.



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Get great shots with little of no budget?

I agree it's quite difficult to get a professional photographer to do a shoot if you only have a fairly small amount of money to spend.

However, I hope my answers to the HOW TO's do help to get you started! I can also recommend to check out local colleges, often these students already developed a nice style and don't ask that much. Most of the time it turns out you have to pay for great quality though..

Shoot close to the artist,

Capture emotions, pay attention to details and minimize the use of flash!

BUDGET:

Use the slides to get you or someone talented around you started or try local colleges to discover the unknown talent!
