WASHINGTON, D.C., May 28, 2010 – Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) members are concerned and saddened by the recent events in China. The EICC Board of Directors is establishing a multi-company task force based in Asia to assess where the EICC can best offer support. The Board expects to engage multiple parties in the task force to better understand the issues and to support relevant work across the entire electronics industry. More details will be shared once the scope of EICC activities is finalized.

The EICC was established in 2004 to improve social, economic, and environmental conditions in the global electronic supply chain through use of a standardized code of conduct.
