DEADLINE April 5, 2010. Please submit a complete Undergraduate Scholarship Application, an official copy of SAT or ACT scores, an official school transcript and a photograph. Current college students need only to submit transcript of grades. In order to ensure a fair process, NO EXTENSIONS will be granted. The deadline date is the U.S. Postal date stamp indicated above. Please affix your name and nome address to the back of a photograph. Faxed submissions will not be accepted.
ENROLLMENT Must have written evidence of acceptance to an accredited college/university for 2010 fall school year. Current college students must have proof of "C" average; GPA will be a final determining selection factor along with other criteria. Please attach a copy of your institution's rating system to clarify any numbered grade such as 4.0 as an A or 2.5 as a C.
RECOMMENDATIONSMust have at least three letters of recommendation from people other than relatives, dated and addressed to the CBTU Scholarship Committee. (Repeat applicants do not send same letters year after year.)
CBTU SPONSOR Provide the name, relationship, signature and contact number of the CBTU member who is the sponsor of scholarship applicant to the Scholarship Awards Committee. Sponsor must be a current dues paid member recorded in the National CBTU Office by April 26 of current year.
Must submit a typewritten essay of no less than 300 words, subjects as follows, freshman year students essay subject: Why Should Young People get Involved in Politics? For applicants entering their sophomore year the essay is to be entitled: Leadership and Services, What does it Mean. In addition include in your essay an example of your Leadership and Service. Titled essays for students in their junior year, "Valuing our Vote;" The student who has reached the senior year is asked to present an essay entitled: A College Education, Provides Me Choices.
