Colonel Ann Wright is a former United States Army colonel and retired official of the U.S. State Department, known for her outspoken opposition to the Iraq War. She is most noted for having been one of three State Department officials to publicly resign in protest of the March 2003 invasion of Iraq.

She was a passenger on the *Challenger 1*, which, with the *Mavi Marmara*, was part of the Gaza flotilla that was attacked in international waters while trying to break the blockade and take humanitarian aid to Gaza.
