

**THE HOUSING AND PLANNING DELIVERY GRANT DETERMINATION 2010 No.  
31/1732**

The Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government (“the Secretary of State”) makes the following determination in exercise of the powers conferred by-

- a. section 15 of the Norfolk and Suffolk Broads Act 1988;
- b. section 72 of the Environment Act 1995; and
- c. section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003.

Citation

1. This determination may be cited as the Housing and Planning Delivery Grant Determination 2010 No. 31/1732.

Purpose of the grant

2. The purpose of the grant allocated by this determination to local planning authorities in England is to provide support towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them, particularly, but not exclusively, in respect of their planning functions.

Determination

3. The Secretary of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the maximum amount of grant payable to each of those authorities, the authorities and amounts as listed in Annex A. Authorities listed in Annex A are referred to as ‘receiving authorities’ in this determination.

Grant Conditions

4. Pursuant to-
  - a. section 15(1) of the Norfolk and Suffolk Broads Act 1988,
  - b. section 72(1) of the Environment Act 1995, and
  - c. section 31(4) and (5) of the Local Government Act 2003, and

the Secretary of State determines that the grant will be paid subject to the conditions in Annex B.

Consultation


6. Before determining-
  - a. the amount of grant payable to National Park authorities in England and the Broads Authority; and
  - b. the purpose for which that grant is to be made;

the Secretary of State consulted Natural England and the Department for the Environment Food and Rural Affairs.

## **Annex B**

### **Grant Conditions**

#### Definition

1. In this Determination:
  - a. 'grant element' means a portion of overall grant which has been allocated to a receiving authority in respect of one of the following:
    - i. Housing completions,
    - ii. Demonstrating sufficient land for housing, publication of a Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment and involvement of a Housing Market Partnership,
    - iii. Plan making,
    - iv. Joint working, and
    - v. Strategic Housing Market Assessments; and
  - b. the amount of grant, or the reduced amount of grant, allocated to a receiving authority may be a zero amount.

#### Withholding Grant and Requesting Further Information

2. In cases where the Secretary of State has concerns about whether statistical data or other information relating to a receiving authority is fraudulent, erroneous, inaccurate, incomplete or compiled in error, for whatever cause, and such data or information is relevant for the purposes of grant allocated under this determination, he may withhold up to, or exactly, 10% of the amount of any or all grant elements allocated to that authority by virtue of this determination.
3. Where the Secretary of State has such concerns he may request further statistical data or other information from the receiving authority by a specified date, which must be a date at least 28 days after the date on which the request is made.
4. If grant has been withheld under paragraph 2, and the Secretary of State is subsequently satisfied that no reduction is appropriate under paragraph 5, he must pay the withheld grant to the receiving authority.

#### Reductions in the Amount of Grant Allocated

5. Where grant was allocated to a receiving authority on the basis of statistical data or other information (either relating to that authority or relating to any other authority but which affected the amount of grant allocated to that authority) which is subsequently shown to be fraudulent, erroneous, inaccurate, incomplete or compiled in error, for whatever cause, the Secretary of State may reduce the amount of grant allocated to that authority under this determination. He may do this whether or not he has previously withheld any amount of grant under the condition in paragraph 2 or requested further statistical data or other information from the authority under the condition in paragraph 3.
6. Where the Secretary of State has requested further statistical data or other information from a receiving authority and the authority has failed to provide further data or information by the date specified by the Secretary of State, the Secretary of State may reduce the amount of grant allocated to the authority under this determination by up to, or exactly, 50% of that amount. He may do this whether or not he has previously withheld any amount of grant under the condition in paragraph 2.

7. If, by virtue of paragraph 5 or 6, the Secretary of State reduces the amount of grant allocated to a receiving authority:
  - a. he shall notify the authority of the reduced amount of grant allocated;
  - b. where the reduced amount of grant allocated is less than the amount of any grant already paid to that authority under this determination, the amount of grant paid in excess of the reduced amount shall become immediately repayable by the authority;
  - c. where the reduced amount of grant allocated is more than the amount of any grant already paid to that authority under this determination, the Secretary of State shall pay to the authority the balance of the reduced amount of grant allocated; and
  - d. the Secretary of State may retain the amount of any grant originally allocated to the authority which is in excess of the reduced amount of grant allocated to that authority.

#### Repayment of Overpaid Grant

8. If a receiving authority is erroneously paid more grant than the amount of grant allocated under this determination, the amount of grant paid in excess of the amount allocated shall become immediately repayable by the authority.

#### No Obligation to Increase Allocations

9. The Secretary of State is under no obligation to increase the amount of any grant allocated or payable to any authority by virtue of this determination, whether or not more complete or accurate data or other information comes to his attention subsequent to the making of this determination in relation to that authority or any other authority.

#### Application of Conditions to Reduced Allocations

10. Where the amount of grant allocated to a receiving authority has been reduced in accordance with the conditions in this Annex, the conditions in this Annex shall then apply in relation to the reduced amount of grant allocated as they applied in relation to the amount of grant previously allocated to the authority under this determination.
