"Dare to Begin" - That is the motto of singer/ composer/musician from the UK - Navin. Because if you dare to begin, then your dreams can take shape and become realities.

One such dream did come true for Navin, when filmmaker Sajid Nadiadwala chose him as

a playback singer for the song 'Freedom', in the Bollywood film 'Kambakkht Ishq', after music director Anu Malik heard him singing a song for his new album. He and fellow UK artist Veronica will be singing Freedom, which is picturised on the main stars of the film, Akshay Kumar and Kareena Kapoor.

When asked what it feels like being chosen as a Bollywood play-back singer, he responded resoundingly - "It feels awesome! I have grown up listening to Bollywood music and I am a big fan of Akshay Kumar, so to be given the opportunity to sing for him still feels somewhat unreal." How did it all come about? "It was through producer Rishi Rich that it came about. Rishi was working with Bollywood music director Anu Malik and he played a song that I had recorded for my new album. Anu Malik liked my voice, so Rishi rang me up and casually said, 'Come down to the studio. Anu Malik is here and wants you to record for Akshay Kumar on his next Bollywood movie.' I was like ... what??? I thought he was playing a prank on me but it was for real and it was an awesome experience recording with them!

Amazing! However, if we look back just five years ago, the events related to Navin's singing were just beginning. Let us travel backwards in time to January 2004 and see where it all began.

At only 19 years of age, he represented the UK on the World Series of Zee TV's Sa Re Ga Ma stage in Dubai. The following year, he went on to win the BBC Asian Network's Unsung competition, performing live at the prestigious Birmingham Symphony Hall. In between all his many public performances in various places around the UK, Germany, Holland and South Africa, Navin has been working diligently on composing, singing and producing his debut album, which will be out this year.

Some of the tracks we can look forward to are Tukde, Tukde (Pieces), Zinda Hoon (I am Alive), Main Ha Tere Naal (I am with you), Khaali Dil (Empty Heart), Love Thing (which features the world-famous Bindiya Chamkegi from 'Do Raaste', sung by Lata Mangeshkar), Fade Away, and Tere Liye (For You).

'Tere Liye', his newest and most romantic song to date released on February 14, 2009. It debuted on the UK Unity Charts at #3 and two weeks later was at #1!

Navin has performed at the SilverDome in Holland and several other countries including Dubai last month, at the top of the seven-star Burj-al-Arab hotel no less. His most recent performance took place in the Big Apple. On May 9 he was singing his heart and soul out in the Grand Ballroom of the historic Cipriani's Hotel in Manhattan at the South Asian Excellence Awards. The two-and-a-half


