### Education Endowment Fund

Many young boys and girls who do not have the opportunity to go to school come each day to the Informal School at the Chappell Centre hoping they will receive some teaching and be chosen to go to school. Others are presently going to school - orphans, children of desperately poor parent(s) but they have no certainty of continuing their education without support - support that the education endowment Fund provides.

*(We do not offer our sponsors lunches, gifts or other incentives, just the knowledge that you are giving life and hope to a child.)*

### Secondary Education

You can provide the means for a child to have a secondary education and give the boy or girl tuition, accommodation, books and clothing for one year...of course you can continue with this child and make him or her part of your family.

### Primary Education

Every child deserves the chance to go to primary school and you can support a young child by providing them with the necessities to attend a good school and receive a basic education.

### Family Support

There are many 1 parent families that struggle to have a home, food and clothing. The parent may be ill or he/she may be a guardian that has to care for other children as well so life does become very difficult. There is no government support for these families.

### Post Secondary Education

Many children leave school and do not have the financial means to continue their education. They can then fall between the cracks – they are intelligent and hard working young people who would appreciate a chance to make something of their lives.

#### *Support a University Student*

This will give a gifted student who has done well in Secondary School the chance to make a difference.

#### *Support a Business College Student*

A great opportunity for a young man or woman to study for a career.

#### *Support a Hairdressing, Tailoring, Catering or similar Diploma Student*

This gives the young person a chance to get a job or start their own business

We are sometimes asked: “Why send a child to a secondary boarding school?”

- \* It provides a safe environment away from the dangers of Kibera.
- \* The students have a bed, regular meals, good tuition and the opportunity to study (the schools have electricity) and use learning facilities.
- \* They can enjoy extra curricular activities not available in Kibera such as music and sports.
- \* It is a home for orphans.

These children come each day to the Informal School in Kibera at the Chappell Centre, hoping that someone will teach them or give them a book.
