MONK PARAKEET (*Myiopsitta monachus*)

IDENTIFICATION

27-30 cm. Green yellowish upperparts: grey forehead; grey brown chest, with pale transversal lines; green wings with blue coverts; green bluish tail; light brown bill.

SIMILAR SPECIES

This species is unmistakable

SEXING

Plumage of both sexes alike. Size is usually helpful with extreme birds: **male** with wing longer than 155 mm; **female** with wing shorter than 151 mm.

AGEING

2 types of age can be recognized:
Juvenile with grey forehead tinged green.
Adult with pure grey forehead.
 After the **postbreeding/postjuvenile** moult, ageing is not possible using plumage characters.

MOULT

Complete **postbreeding** and **postjuvenile** moult, usually finished in September.

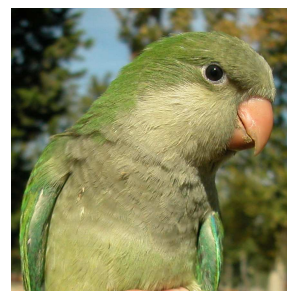
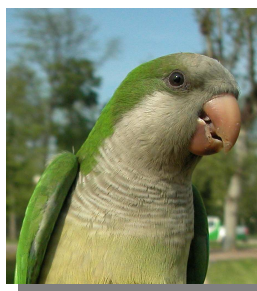

Monk Parakeet. Juvenile (08-VIII).

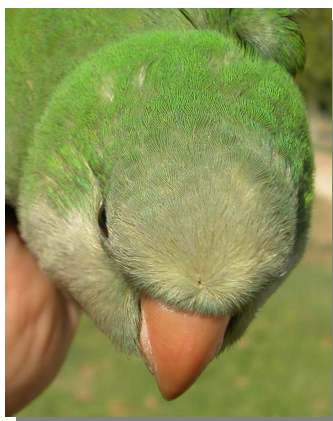


Monk Parakeet. Head pattern: top adult (21-IV); bottom juvenile (08-VIII).

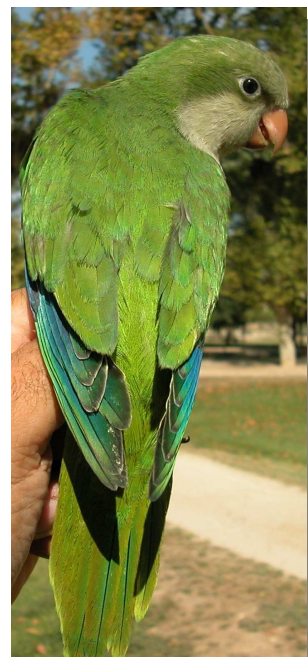


Monk Parakeet. Breast pattern: left adult (21-IV); right juvenile (08-VIII).

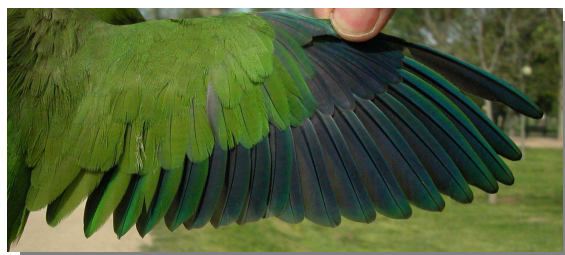

Monk Parakeet. Forehead pattern: top adult (21-IV); bottom juvenile (08-VIII).



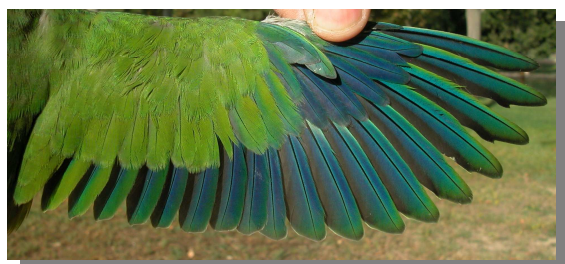
Monk Parakeet. Upperpart pattern: left adult (21-IV); right juvenile (08-VIII).
