
J Street PAC

JStreetPAC is the first political action committee

specifically established to endorse and raise money for candidates for federal office who support active American leadership to bring peace and security to Israel and the Middle East.



Building on the success of our inaugural cycle in 2008, JStreetPAC distributed over \$1.5 million to 61 endorsed candidates, more than 2.5 times than what we distributed in the last cycle and the most in history by any pro-Israel PAC.

JStreetPAC and its slate of endorsed candidates fared well in the face of the most toxic political atmosphere in recent memory. Overall, 45 of 61 endorsees won their races, including 82% (45 of 55) of House incumbents we endorsed this election cycle.

The PAC disbursed an average of \$24,520 per candidate, with 26 endorsees receiving \$20,000 or more. This financial support came from an expansive fundraising network including thousands of online donors, 11 PAC events held in cities across the country, and from a National Finance Committee made up of 86 members.


JStreetPAC COMES OUT STRONG FOR JAN SCHAKOWSKY



Rep. Jan Schakowsky (IL-9) is a leading Jewish voice in Congress and a longtime supporter of Israel and the two-state solution. JStreetPAC is proud to have endorsed Rep. Schakowsky for each of the last two election cycles. Despite having an impeccable record of support for Israel, Schakowsky came under attack this cycle by a neoconservative, Tea Party-backed opponent who made Schakowsky's record on Israel and JStreetPAC endorsement a central focus of his campaign.

JStreetPAC stepped up on Rep. Schakowsky's behalf through online fundraising appeals, contributions from Chicago area leadership, and mobilizing supporters to attend various events and publish letters in area newspapers. Polling shows that her opponent's attacks backfired and Schakowsky won decisively with strong support from the Jewish community and over \$75,000 from JStreetPAC.
