Issues young people are facing today

In modern Ireland, young people are once again facing the grim prospects of low-quality education, unemployment, poverty, and emigration. Almost all the problems of Ireland's youth can be traced back to the gangster capitalism developed by current and previous governments and supported by all establishment parties. Fifty thousand people are going to emigrate from Ireland this year—a massive blow to a country with a population of $6\frac{1}{4}$ million. With jobs vanishing daily, choices are disappearing for young people leaving school. And with the cuts to social welfare planned by Fine Gael, it seems that poverty is one of the few options for those who choose to stay.

National issues in Ireland today

The greatest issue in Ireland today is its national debt. The state now owes more than €97 billion in debt but has guaranteed potentially hundreds of billions more. This is €21,000 of debt for each person. (You can follow the fast-increasing debt at www.nodebt.ie.)

The Connolly Youth Movement is taking part in the Repudiate the Debt campaign. This is a

campaign to get the weight of the debt off the taxpayers and workers of Ireland and instead place it on the speculators, bankers and gamblers who incurred it. The only way Ireland can overcome this debt, which will cripple us for decades and is forcing the sale of our





sovereignty, is to demand a referendum for repudiation of the debt. Why should our future and our children's futures be sacrificed to bail out banks in Germany, Britain, and the United States?

Because of this debt, we don't have sufficient resources to maintain the hospitals, welfare system or other integral parts of society. We are spending money that could improve the lives of Irish people on keeping a handful of bankers and speculators rich and happy. The International Monetary Fund has already gone into many countries, where they produced a deal that the country could not ever

possibly pay. Upon not being able to repay the debt, the IMF came into those countries and robbed them of their valuable public companies and stole billions in gas and oil.

The Government has already sold many of its public companies, and the EU and IMF plan more. The state has already begun selling parts of the country itself through the sale of acres of forests to transnational corporations!

Under the control of the European Union, we have lost many of our rights as a nation. We have lost our fishing waters and other resources. We cannot even protect our national resources without incurring the wrath of the EU. With the combination of pressure from the EU and now the IMF, Irish citizens no longer have a say in how their country is run. Votes for Labour, Fine Gael and Fianna Fáil were all votes for the same establishment, with the same interests and the same intentions. The intention of these parties is to continue selling Ireland to international interests.
