Planeta Verde Reforestación S.A.



Our Mission is to plant tropical trees as a green investment in the Orinoco River basin of Vichada, Colombia. Planting tropical trees is profitable, good for the planet, good for endangered wildlife, good for humans and a scientifically proven solution to climate change. We are accomplishing our mission in a financially and environmentally sustainable manner with predictable outcomes.

Planeta Verde Reforestación S.A. has been planting tropical trees for lumber, carbon sequestration, expanded wildlife habitat and profit in Latin America since 2006. The company has operations in Colombia, Panama and Costa Rica. Our Colombian wholly-owned subsidiary is called *Plantación Amazonia El Vita S.A.*, and our marketing division's trade names are *Amazonia Reforestation™* and *CO2 Tropical Trees™*.

Achievements include a forecast maturity value of \$45.7 million USD in *Acacia*, *Eucalyptus*, *Pine* and native trees under cultivation, with tree farm infrastructure in place, such as buildings, vehicles, machinery, power, water and tree nurseries, and with employment for up to 40 people depending on the season. We have established *La Pedregoza Natural Reserve*.



Our Plantation in Vichada, Colombia, is called *La Pedregoza* and is some 3,100 hectares or 7,650 acres in size, with 29% planted in 2011. *Planeta Verde* owns 105 HP tractors and a full complement of tree farm machinery. We can also plant tropical trees at the nearby 3,000 hectare or 7,410 acre *Roncador* plantation.

Afforestation and Reforestation Services include use of certified seeds and wild seed collection, tree nursery operations, soil preparation, deep ploughing and cultivating, and fertilization using special forestry mixes. Our tree care and maintenance philosophy is tree ranching for best lumber and sale results.

Past Performance includes operation of a plantation in Tamil Nadu, India from 1995 to 2009, tropical tree holdings in the San Carlos district of Costa Rica since 2006 and in the RAAN district of Nicaragua in 2008. *Planeta Verde* presently has 672,129 tropical trees under cultivation in Colombia.

Certifications are pending for FSC lumber (*Forest Stewardship Council*) and for forest carbon offsets. *Planeta Verde* can obtain carbon certifications required by a customer for specific purposes (Climate Exchange, Kyoto, etc.).

Partnerships include the renowned *Fundación Omacha* in Bogotá, Colombia, the *Faculty of Agricultural, Life and Environmental Sciences* at the University of Alberta in Edmonton, Canada, and the multi-national European *Tree-Nation* portal in Barcelona, Spain.

Memberships include the *Corporación Orinquia Verde* (Corpoverde), the *Asociación Red Colombiana de Reservas Naturales de la Sociedad Civil* (Resnatur), and the United Nations' 2011 *International Year of Forests*.
