Nomination Deadline
September 15

IMPORTANT

- All nomination materials must be submitted in **two ways**:*
 1. Both in electronic format **via email** to researchfellows@sloan.org;
 2. And in hardcopy format **via mail** (or FedEx, UPS, courier, etc.) to Sloan Research Fellowships, Alfred P. Sloan Foundation, 630 Fifth Avenue, Suite 2550, New York, NY 10111-0242.

Nominations will not be considered complete unless materials are received in both formats. Materials must be postmarked on or before the September 15th deadline.

*Letters of support can arrive separately and need not be submitted in both formats.

- Please submit nomination materials as a single bookmarked file in .pdf format with the materials arranged in the following order: nomination form, nominator's letter, C.V., publication list (if separate from C.V.), personal research statement, representative article #1, representative article #2. **NOTE:** The Foundation's email system cannot accept files in .zip, .zipx or other archive formats.
- All nominated candidates for the Sloan Research Fellowships are asked to email a completed [Confidential Nominee Survey](#) to researchfellows@sloan.org. Data are collected for statistical purposes only. Individual answers are not shared with members of the selection committees and will not affect selection committee decisions.

FURTHER CLARIFICATIONS

- **"Fellowship Field"**: Candidates should use this field to indicate which of the eight selection committees should review a candidate's nomination materials. Options are chemistry, computational and evolutionary molecular biology, computer science, economics, mathematics, neuroscience, ocean sciences, and physics.
- **"Applicable Specialization"**: Candidates seeking fellowships in chemistry, neuroscience, or physics should use this field to indicate which of the disciplinary specializations provided best describes their most significant work. If more than one specialization applies, select the most relevant one provided. Candidates seeking fellowships in computer science, mathematics, molecular biology, or ocean sciences need not provide information on their specialization and can select "None of the above".
- **"Degree Received"**: Candidates educated outside the U.S. and who did not receive a Bachelor's, Master's, or Ph.D. should use these fields to provide information about relevantly equivalent degrees or academic certifications the candidate has received.
