## Amtrak/FEC Corridor Project

Thank you for your continued interest in the Amtrak/FEC Corridor Project. FDOT is moving forward with completion of an updated application for High Speed / Intercity Passenger Rail funding for the project. As part of the application process, the regional planning councils are assisting FDOT with a series of public workshops to inform the public and obtain public input to develop conceptual plans for stations to be located in communities.

In each of the eight communities, two public meetings are scheduled as follows:

## (1) PUBLIC WORKSHOP (6-8 pm; specific dates & locations below)

This public workshop is designed to introduce the public to the project and obtain public input regarding station location alternatives within the previously identified cities. Participants will review informational boards from 6 - 6:30 PM, and a brief project presentation will be conducted at 6:30 PM, followed by an informal question & answer session.

## (2) STATION DESIGN SESSION (variable times during the workday with specific dates, times and locations below)

This workshop will allow participants (particularly representatives from local governments, agencies, and Amtrak) to review public input from the "public workshop" as well as data obtained through the EDTM process and architecturally "test" the station location alternatives to determine a preferred station location for the particular city. The goal of the workshop will be to develop a draft conceptual plan for one or more station locations that identified appropriate locations for station infrastructure (station building, platform, parking), access, and related transit-oriented development. This workshop will be facilitated by TCRPC staff, and results will be presented back to the participants and the public in a subsequent public workshop (prior to formal presentation to the City Commission).
