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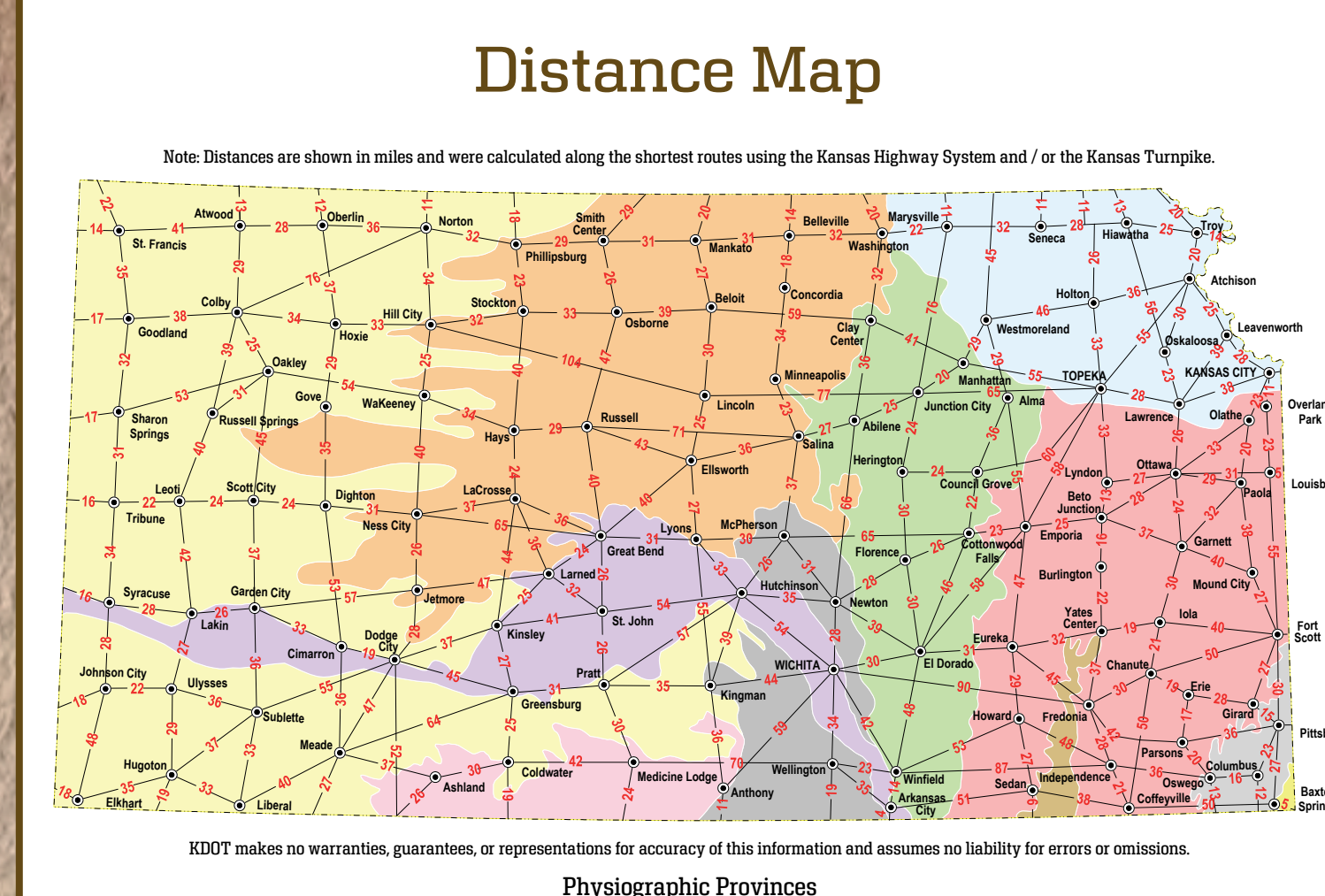
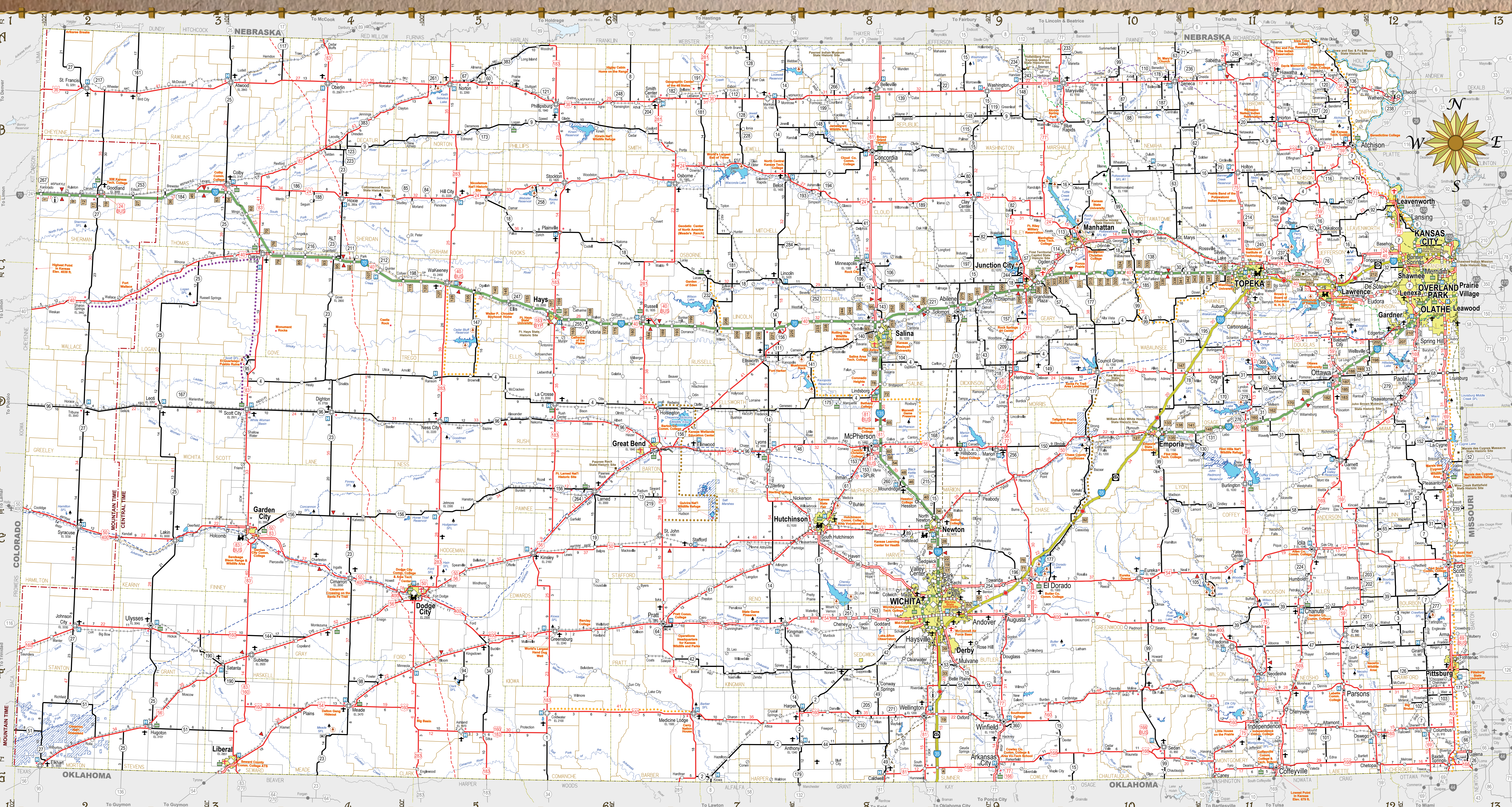

New Kansas Laws

Primary Seatbelt Enforcement – Law enforcement officers can stop and ticket drivers and front-seat passengers for not wearing safety belts. Adults traveling in the back seat without safety belts may also be fined if another citation is issued.

Texting-While-Driving Pen – Drivers are prohibited from reading, writing or sending text messages and anyone caught texting will be fined.
