

Twin psychics who say they can see into your future—we tested 'em out.

all, beautiful, blond twins may be every guy's fantasy, but will it really double your (psychic) pleasure and double your (psychic) fun to have two identical people giving you a reading? I mean, couldn't twin psychics turn out to be a big portion of overkill, with a little gimmick on the side? That was my initial thought when I was asked to interview the world-famous Psychic Twins, Terry and Linda Jamison, who've appeared on NBC's The Other Half and numerous other TV shows.

But I consider myself an open-minded person, eager to explore every option, so I started thinking, if one is good, maybe two is better. After all, I have two cats to keep each other company. And just in case one screws up, there are usually two men in my life at any given moment.

We both live in L.A., so I suggested they come to my house to chat and do a reading, thinking that a quiet atmosphere would be

important. "We would love to come to your home," they told me. "But we're very allergic to cats." Cats? How did they know I had cats? Oh yeah. Psychic. We met at a local restaurant, since they assured me that they can channel anywhere, any time.

It seems they've had psychic powers all their life. They don't reveal their true ages, but will admit they're "closer to 40 than 30." Their abilities to see into the future for oth-

time, however, was that much of their inspiration and talent came as a result of channeling. "You know how when you create something, you sometimes feel as if it's coming from somewhere else, and going sort of through you and onto the paper?" asks Linda. "That's creative channeling."

The twins started their own performing arts company which would perform music, comedy, dance and acrobatics in New York and Washington, D.C. Among the perform-

ers began manifesting themselves during the twins' teenage years. "When we were in high

school," says Terry, "we used to just know things about our friends, like who they should date and what they should study. We told one friend to go into television news, and now he's a prominent news anchor."





ing characters they created was Louise the Two-Headed Housewife, who actually became a regularly featured character on NBC's Saturday Night Live. That brought the twins to California for their own series on the short-lived HA comedy channel.

All the while, however, the twins were suffering from horrific physical problems. They'd experienced intense pain for more than 20 years, and were diagnosed with everything from lupus to cancer to chemical poisoning. "We had nowhere else to go for healing but to another realm," says Linda. They sought the help of psychic healers, who not only aided them in overcoming their pain, but also introduced them to the world of metaphysics and told them something they'd both known, deep down inside—that they had a psychic gift.

"We'd Watch Unsolved Mysteries...and Solve Them"

"We didn't just run out and start doing readings," explains Terry. "We practiced for a long time. We'd watch Unsolved Mysteries on television, and we'd solve them, and then watch the show's updates, plus check the newspaper, to see if we'd been accurate."

They discovered they received inspiration through an original form of automatic writing. This involved drawing circles on a legal pad while concentrating on a person or

an issue, and then letting spirit guides take over. Soon they begin writing words and phrases about that person or issue, their hands guided by "spiritual" sources.

They do this independently of each other, but compare notes when they're finished, and their notes are always eerily similar. With me, they'd both written the same things down: That I'd had a traumatic experience at the age of 12, probably from my parents divorcing (that was true!); that I had ex-lovers who were current friends by the names of Dan and David (again, completely true); and that men named Michael play an important part in my life (two of my closest family members bear that name).

They also made some interesting shortterm predictions that came true within a couple of weeks of the reading. They saw me going on a trip to Las Vegas (after the interview, I was invited to accompany a friend who was taking a weekend class there). They told me my current relationship was short-term and would be ending soon (it ended within a week of the reading), and they said a little girl would soon be coming into my life. A few weeks after the reading, I started dating a man named Michael who has a 4-year-old daughter.

They both said I would eventually meet my soul mate, but it would take about three years before I'd marry him.

"People Hang Up on Us When We Tell Them They'll Break Up With Someone"

"We're always very honest," they concurred. "We've actually had people hang up on us because we've told them they would break up with someone they were dating."

But they've also saved people's lives. They told one client that her new husband was having an affair with his own stepsister, who was living in their home at the time, and that criminals surrounded the client. Her husband, his stepsister, and many of their relatives turned out to be grifters, and are currently serving time in prison.

The Psychic Twins are also called upon to help solve crimes by the FBI and other government agencies and have helped find missing children. They claim that the body of Laci Peterson, the pregnant woman who disappeared from her California home last Christmas, is lying in a watery grave, and that blood evidence found in the car and boat of her husband will be enough to convict him and put him away for good.

Their Most Chilling Prediction

But perhaps their most chilling prediction came on nationally syndicated radio, on Art Bell's Coast to Coast show late in 1999. They both said they saw a terrorist attack

opinion of their talents, I asked them to do a reading for my friend Mary Lou. She got her reading over the phone and said that Linda began the conversation coughing, and explained that she was responding to Mary Lou's fear of speaking, centered in a chakra

They gave Mary Lou information about her "spirit guides" and told her about past lives she'd led. "I felt that they were accurate as well as helpful in directing me to move forward," she said. "I liked the fact that they were authentic in giving me a general overview while at the same time giving me the

awareness to take responsibility for my life. Ahhh, easier breathing already!"

"We like to think of ourselves as success coaches," the twins agree. "We help people zero in on what they really want, and how they can achieve it. And we can help them change their destinies, if they're open to it."

The Psychic Twins give readings to people all over the world, in person, via phone, or over the Internet. Their prices are surprisingly reasonable for celebrity psychics, ranging from \$50 for 15 minutes with one twin to \$250 for both for an hour, and just
