FINAL JUDGMENT OF DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

- 1. The Wife and Respondent/Husband, ELDRICK TONT WOODS ("<u>Husband</u>") have been residents of the State of Florida for more than six (6) months prior to the commencement of this action.
 - 2. The parties were duly married to each other on October 5, 2004.
- 3. The parties hereto are *sui juris*, and neither is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States or any of its allies.
 - 4. The marriage between the parties is irretrievably broken.
- 5. There is no reason to continue the proceeding to allow the parties to attempt reconciliation.

- 6. There are two (2) children born of the parties' marriage, to wit: Sam Alexis Woods, born June 18, 2007 and Charlie Axel Woods, born February 8, 2009. There are no other minor children born of the marriage nor are any children expected.
- 7. The parties freely and voluntarily entered into a Marital Settlement Agreement dated July 3, 2010, signed by the parties on July 3 and 4, 2010, which includes a Parenting Plan, also signed by the parties on July 3 and 4, 2010, with the intent to be bound thereby. For purposes of identification, the Court has initialed the Marital Settlement Agreement.
- 8. There is good cause to waive the twenty (20) day waiting period, and an injustice would result from delay in entry of a final judgment of dissolution of marriage.

THEREUPON, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** as follows:

- A. The marriage between the Petitioner/Wife, ELIN MARIA PERNILLA WOODS, and the Respondent/Husband, ELDRICK TONT WOODS, is hereby dissolved because it is irretrievably broken.
- B. The Marital Settlement Agreement is adopted and confirmed by this Court. The parties are ordered to abide by and comply with the terms of the Marital Settlement Agreement dated July 3, 2010, including the Parenting Plan, in every respect.
- C. The Wife's maiden name, ELIN MARIA PERNILLA NORDEGREN is hereby restored by this Court, and the Wife shall hereinafter be known by her former name.
- D. The Court retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties hereto for purposes of enforcement of this Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage and to enter subsequent orders necessary to effect the terms of the Marital Settlement Agreement dated July 3, 2010, including the Parenting Plan. Venue for any such actions shall be in any venue

appropriate under the law and under the facts and circumstances as they exist at the time such action is filed.
