Comrades and friends, by now we all know that the boss/worker relationship has been radicallyrestructured over the past thirty years. Work is increasingly casualised, outsourced and 'externalised', to the point where many workers do not know who their employer is. The result of the restructuring is a highly divided workplace, of permanents, casuals, labour broker workers, contract workers and young 'learners' who serve as an additional source of cheap labour (learnerships, internships, stipend workers, volunteers). Many of the new workers are women, youth and 'undocumented migrants', for want of a better description. The workplace is riddled by tensions across employment status, gender, age and nationalist divides. The only beneficiaries of these divisions are the bosses.

The established trade union movement shows little appetite for the difficult task of organizing the new workers, despite their increasing number and social and political significance. The Casual Workers Advice Office is a first, tentative step towards organizing such workers. The organisation is registered as an NPO (registration number 93222), a bank account has been opened, systems started up and the doors will open in Germistonwithin weeks. The CWAO has a fulltime co-ordinatorand one organizer/paralegal to start with, reporting to the CWAO Management Committee¹.

While the CWAO has been fortunate to attract a small amount of start up funding, the intention has always been to try and keep the initiative as free of donor dependence as possible. The strategy to do so hinges on sympathisers makingmonthly donationsuntil such time as the workers using the services of the CWAO begin to assume responsibility for its on-going existence, based on their understanding of its role of encouraging organisation among vulnerable workers.

The CWAO requests you to consider making a monthly contribution. Contributions will go directly into the account of the CWAO and all contributors will receive regular financial statements and progress reports on the work of the advice office.
