On 051610 at 0728 hours I responded to 350 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Loveland, CO. 80537 in reference to windows possibly being shot out. When I arrived I saw that unit #13 at 350 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street had 6 of the east facing windows broken out, 4 of the west facing windows broken out, and several landscape rocks lying near the broken windows. I took several photographs of the damage, and found no collectible evidence. It didn't appear entry to the business was made.

At 0743 hours I attempted to phone the property owner/manager, BARRY FLOYD, and left a message. At 0815 hours I went to BARRY FLOYD's last known address, [REDACTED] Loveland, CO. When I arrived the current homeowner said BARRY sold this house to him and was unable to give me a current address for BARRY. At 0823 hours I again phoned BARRY and left a message which included Loveland Police Department's case number 10-3597.

After leaving 350 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street dispatch said the other owner of the property, GARY L. HAUSMAN, DOB [REDACTED], was at 350 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street. I met with HAUSMAN and gave him my business card with case number and asked that when he has a total dollar amount on the damage to call me.

Later in the day I responded back to 350 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street and met with ICE Agent Jerene R. Gilliam. Gilliam said their office was forwarded an informational e-mail from their intelligence agent in reference to attacks on ICE substations. In the e-mail the ICE substation at 350 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street is listed. A copy of this e-mail is enclosed with this report, as has also been posted in the bull pen area in the Loveland Police Department. I left a voicemail message for on call Detective Cortina in regards to this case.
