**2011 - 2012 ANNUAL EEO PUBLIC FILE REPORT**

The purpose of this EEO Public File Report (“Report”) is to comply with Section 73.2080(c)(6) of the FCC’s EEO Rule. This Report has been prepared on behalf of the Station Human Resources Unit that is comprised of the following stations: KOMO-TV & KUNS-TV and Fisher Radio Seattle stations: KOMO(AM), KVI(AM), KPLZ-FM, and KOMO-FM (by virtue of time brokerage) and is required to be placed in the public inspection files of these stations, and posted on their Websites.

For purposes of this Report, a vacancy was deemed “filled” not when the offer was extended but when the hiree accepted the job offer. A person was deemed “interviewed” whether he or she was interviewed in person, over the telephone or by e-mail.

**COMMUNITY EVENTS:**

On 10/8/2011, Steve Pool recorded video (DVD) message to "Friends of the Children" group as part of the evening program. The agency mentors kids K-18yrs; 85% graduate high school and 93% avoid jail. Kids play a role in the evening as well. They see Steve as a role model. "Friends of the Children" is a one-to-one mentoring program which sticks with kids until age 18 with 400 attendees.

On 12/6/2011, Steve Pool served a keynote presenter and emcee for premiere of Lucas Films "Red Tails" movie about the Tuskegee Airmen, at Naval Station Whidbey for the Sam Bruce Chapter/Seattle. Approximately 400 middle-school and high school students attended and participated in a panel discussion with the Airmen, actors, and other film people. The 400 students were inspired by Steve's message to stay in school to become a success, like he and the Tuskegee Airmen did.

Martin Luther King, Jr./Seattle Community College Celebration Friday, Jan 13, 2012 at Mt. Zion Baptist Church with our station's Senior Anchor, Molly Shen as emcee inspiring the 900 student attendees.

On 2/9/2012, Brad Goode, Senior Anchor, served as emcee for the annual Boys & Girls Club of King County "Youth of the Year Luncheon" at the Westin Hotel in Seattle with 800 attendees expected.

On 5/17/2012, the station's Business Development Manager Troy Hill served on the University of Washington Foster School of Business Sales Program Panel Discussion. Session held specifically for students to learn about a career in sales as it relates to careers, job challenges and income ranges. Fisher Communications was highlighted as having opportunities in both TV, Radio, on-line and Spanish language, as well as various markets throughout the Northwest.
