Biography

Anthony Rayson (b. 1954) is a self-described anarchist, who authors the zine, *Thought Bombs*, contributes to numerous other zines, enables incarcerated persons to publish and create zines, and operates South Chicago ABC Zine Distro, a distribution network for zines to both individuals and to prisons. In addition, Rayson is a political activist in the Chicago community and beyond.

Description

The Anthony Rayson Zine Collection is divided into three series: Personal, Prison, and Socio-Political. The **Personal** series includes all of Anthony Rayson's personal zines, such as early essays, mini-zines, and speeches that coincide and predate his long-running zine, *Thought Bombs*; materials produced by or for his immediate family, biographical information, and his community involvement with the Peotone Airport protests. The CDs and transcript for a 2008 oral history with Rayson can be found in the biographical files.

The **Prison** series includes four subseries: Prisoner Art, Prisoner Resource Zines, Prisoner Zines, and Prison Protest Materials. The unique contributions of incarcerated persons with a quantity of materials led to personal identifications. The *Each One, Teach One* series of cross interviews between Anthony Rayson and a prisoner is also filed among the individual voices since many of these interviews are with prisoner writings also identified here. Additional groupings of prisoner writings are organized by state and title and by an identifying subject such as Women Prisoners (Box 2) or Native Americans (Box 2). Cross-references have been added to indicate materials that relate to other series. The final subseries includes Prison Protest Materials created by advocates and groups from outside the prison walls. The Prison Protest Materials include prisoner writings, correspondence, and background on prisoners in the system. Not all of these prison protest materials could be considered anarchist in focus.

The **Socio-Political** series includes Anarchist writings from both contemporary networks and writings excerpted from the "classical" or well known Anarchists. Anti-Racist materials are included here because of their Socio-Political nature and as with the anarchists, classical excerpts from the Black Panthers and other ethnic groups are included. Topics of zines in this series also include: Feminist, Punk, and Queer.

Note to researchers: There is overlap between the series. For example, works associated with the Black Panther Party may be found in the Socio-Political series and within the Prison series. Named individual prisoners, such as Kevin Johnson (Rashid), may also be affiliated with the Black Panther Party. Cross-references have been created to help facilitate these connections.

Provenance: Anthony Rayson donated his Zine Collection to DePaul University Special Collections and Archives Department in 2008 (Accession# 2008.04) and continues to send new materials as they become available.
