Research grants for 2013-2014

The **Nordic International Studies Association** now announces up to four research grants for 2013-2014. The purpose is to promote research excellence among Nordic international studies scholars as well as the inclusion of young researchers into the Nordic international studies community.

Funding will be awarded to research workshops of very high quality. At least one of the grants will be awarded to a Ph.D. course, if of very high quality. All events must be organized at a Nordic research institution. Organizers can come from diverse backgrounds but must include at least two Nordic scholars. Depending on the submitted budget, and subject to NISA board approval, a workshop or Ph.D. course can gain the support of up to GBP 7,000.

The theme for the workshops/course must fall within the field of international studies. There is no requirement for co-financing but NISA will look favorably hereon.

Applications must include:

- A cover page with applicants' contact information
- A three-page presentation of purpose and rationale
- A list of participants highlighting confirmed participants
- A letter of support from the hosting institution
- Organizers' CV
- Budget with a fair degree of detail.
- Confirmation of co-financing (if applicable)

The application must be submitted electronically and in pdf-format. All required documents must be integrated into one file and submitted to: nisa.grants@gmail.com. The deadline for filing the application is Friday, 10 September 2013 at noon (CET).

The NISA board will make the funding decision no later than 1 November 2012. The board may call on further information from individual applicants, if deemed desirable. NISA will pay out the lump sum following the event. NISA will not audit expenses but will pay out support once the hosting institution has confirmed the level of expenses.

NISA is a sister organization of the International Studies Association (ISA), and its journal is *Cooperation and Conflict*, published by SAGE.
