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E. Recruitment Initiatives Implemented During the Reporting Period:

During the reporting period, personnel with substantial responsibility for hiring decisions at WBBR participated in two job fairs: one sponsored by UNITY for the Asian American Journalist Association ("AAJA"), National Association of Hispanic Journalists ("NAHJ"), National Lesbian Gay Journalists Association ("NLGJA") and Native American Journalists Association, and one sponsored by National Black Journalist Association ("NABJ").

A variety of training programs are offered to enable WBBR personnel to acquire news skills that may qualify them for higher level positions, including a variety of training programs in management development and reporting on the financial markets. In addition, WBBR offers one-on-one mentoring and voice coaching.

WBBR hired 3 students as paid interns: one college student as part of the 2012 Summer Intern Program; one high school student during the Fall/Winter 2012; and one college student during Winter 2012.

In March 2012, one of WBBR's managers presented a seminar on "Getting it Right: Writing, Delivery, Voicing and Using Sound to Communicate Well in Radio Broadcasting" at the College Media Advisors (CMA) convention in New York. Also in March 2012, 10 students from the CMA came to WBBR for a tour of its facilities, including the studio.

In March 2012, one of WBBR's managers hosted a tour for a group of Curry College students and faculty looking at opportunities for internships and jobs in the New York area, detailed how WBBR reports news and gathers data, and detailed the types of skills WBBR looks for when hiring team members.

In July 2012, one of WBBR's managers hosted a tour for a group of University of Miami School of Communications summer interns.
