We collect information from and about you.

Contact information. For example, we might collect your name and street address. We might also collect your phone number or email.

Payment information. For example, we collect your credit card number when you buy a subscription or pay to access parts of our site.

Demographic information. We may collect information about your interests or hobbies. We might collect this as part of a survey, for example.

Other information. If you use our website, we may collect information about the browser you're using. We might look at what site you came from, or what site you visit when you leave us. If you use our mobile app, we may collect your GPS location. We might look at how often you use the app and where you downloaded it. We collect information in different ways.

We collect information directly from you. For example, if you subscribe for home delivery or register for our newsletter. We also collect information if you post a comment or make a request. We may publish your name if you send a letter to the editor.

We collect information from you passively. We use tracking tools like browser cookies and web beacons. We also collect information from our mobile apps.

We get information about you from third parties. For example, our business partners may give us information about you.

We use information as disclosed and described here.

We use information to respond to your requests or questions. For example, we might use your information to confirm your subscription or register you for a contest. We may use your friend's email address if you send them information from our site.

We use information to improve our products and services. We might use your information to customize your experience with us.

We use information to look at site trends and customer interests. We may use your information to make our website and products better. We may combine information we get from you with information about you we get from third parties.

We use information for security purposes. We may use information to protect our company, our customers, or our websites.

We use information for marketing purposes. For example, we might send you information about special promotions or offers. We might tell you about new features or products. These might be our own offers or products, or third party offers or products we think you might find interesting. We may use push notifications on our mobile apps. To manage this, read the choices section below.

We use information to communicate with you about your account or our relationship. We may contact you about your account or subscription. We might also contact you about this Policy or our website Terms.

We use information to talk to parents or guardians to get permission. We may use contact information to get permission from parents for children who want to use our site.

We use information as otherwise permitted by law. For example, we may use your IP address for identification purposes in cooperation with internet service providers or law enforcement agencies.
