Use of Cookies

The Cancer Society of New Zealand website uses a cookie to store your preferred font size choice. Cookies are small text files that we place in your computer's browser to store your preferences.

We also use Google Analytics to help analyze how users are using the site. Google Analytics uses cookies to track visitor interactions. These cookies are used to store information, such as what time the current visit occurred, whether the visitor has been to the site before, and what site referred the visitor to the web page. This information is not personally identifiable and is not shared with any third party.

Disabling Cookies

Cookies save you time as they can remember what font size you prefer the website to use. Cookies help us to be more efficient as we learn about what content is important to users from your browsing habits.

If you do not wish to have cookies placed on your computer, you can disable them at any time from your Web browser. If you opt out of cookies you will disable cookies from all sources, not just those from the Cancer Society website unless otherwise noted. This may reduce the functionality and user experience of some websites.

The following instructions detail how to disable cookies in popular desktop browsers:

Internet Explorer

- In the "Tools" menu, select "Internet Options"
- Click the "Privacy" tab
- Move the "Settings" slider up or down to adjust your cookie acceptance settings (moving the slider all the way to the top will block all cookies) Or
- Click the "Sites" button to enter specific websites that you wish to allow/disallow to set cookies

Chrome

- Click the wrench icon in the top right of your browser window
- Select "Settings"
- Click the "Show advanced settings"
- Click the "Content Settings" button
- Click the option to "Block sites from setting any data" to block all cookies Or
- Click the "Manage exceptions" button to enter specific websites that you wish to allow/disallow to set cookies

Firefox

- For Windows users, in the "Tools" menu, select "Options".
- For Apple users, in the "Firefox" menu, select "Preferences"
- Click on the "Privacy" button
- Under the "Firefox will:" dropdown, select "Use custom settings for history"
- Uncheck the "Accept Cookies from Sites" box to block all cookies Or
- Click the "Exceptions" button to enter specific websites that you wish to allow/disallow to set cookies

Safari

- Click the "Safari" menu, select "Preferences"
- Select the "Security" tab
- Under "Accept Cookies:", click the "Never" option to block all cookies
