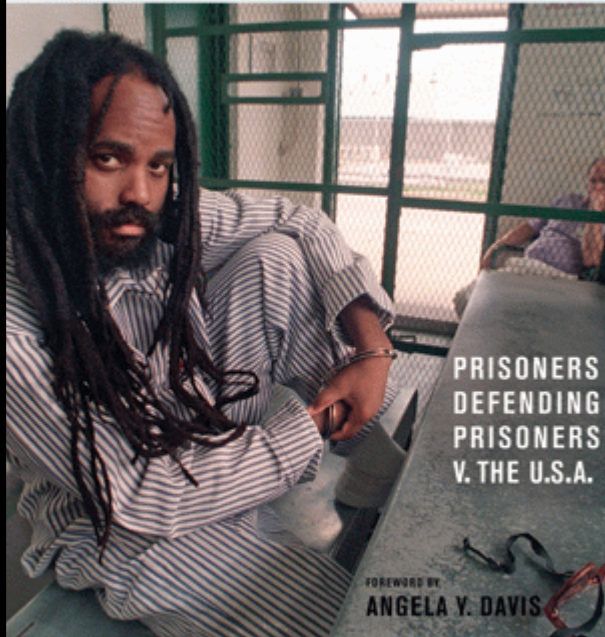


# MORE THAN A BOOK RELEASE! A CELEBRATION OF JAILHOUSE LAWYERS!
