
A 57(M) - THE ROAD TO **ANARCHY**

The 'Mini' RTS announced in Manchester for 30th April, became a major success with a motorway blocked, the city centre gridlocked and 6 hours of partying despite heavy police presence including helicopters, CS gas attacks and cops in riot gear. The plan was to block a side-street near the university, to protest against their transport policies. But the police, expecting the much larger Oxford Road to be taken, sent in the riot squad A couple of cop units surged into the crowd, batonning and stamping on people More people, including many student bystanders, moved in to protect the sound system which was forced back out onto Oxford Road

Now mobile, the party carried on. It moved towards the inner city motorway A57(M) where the party continued for several hours, blocking the traffic over most of South Manchester on Bank

BONFIRES IN THE STREET

After 4 months, the squatted 121 centre in Brixton, South London, is still occupied and awaiting the bailiffs. During that time people have been trying to maintain a 24-hr occupation of the building without losing sight of all the reasons why such autonomous space is so vital and mportant and fun.

It's been hard though, to keep spirits and energy levels high, and find enough to keep us amused in what can be a dark and lonesome building. So people decided to hold a istory, our desire and ability to claim our own space in his world.

On Saturday 10th April - our 86th day of 'resistance'the party took place directly outside the building. The sun came out just as the barricades had been assembled and the sounds were kicking in. The music took a bold, nnovative (and much-appreciated) 'no techno' stance, and was accompanied by dancing puppets and at one stage, show by the 121 striptease team.

Most of the neighbours joined the party (as did an credible number of passing shoppers on their way home rom the market) of an estimated 500 people. The music vent on till late .Police hovered in extremely small umbers and observed, not even complaining about the onfires in the streets!

The party was 'organised' by a handful of people at 2-3 weeks' notice. In response to all the clamours 'why don't you lot do this every week?' we'd like to encourage everyone to organise their own community parties this summer - not necessarily in a street but on any unused and in your area.

The area along the Tarka Trail famous for its otters, has been up for sale for £1Million when it got sold for a tenth of its value to North Devon Asbestos. IN 1999, TO ST. GEORGE'S HILI

On the third of April, 350 years after the original home for the Digger's Memorial Stone, in a public band of revolutionary roundheads that called themselves the Diggers settled in to cultivate St George's Hill in Surrey, a new group of like minded diggers set out to do the same.

In 1649, when the original diggers settled on St George's Hill it was common land. Nowadays it comprises two golf courses and one of the most



exclusive estates in Britain, home to retired dictators and corporate directors alike.

The more recent occupation started with a march of 300 people onto the hill, following which activists continued on to a nearby part of the hill to establish a communal settlement Plants were planted and structures erected.

There was one violent incident a few days later when a resident of the estate pulled up in a four wheel drive vehicle, started removing information boards, and when challenged, punched a man in the face. On the other side of the coin, many residents were supportive of the idea (not to the. point where they gave up their land and privilege, of course!)

One of the aims of the occupation was to increase public rights access to St George's Hill. Specifically, the group tried to find a permanent

In the Open at a GM site in Loanhead in the Lothians during a public site visit. Despite the pleadings of the Green Party members that they did not enter the GM field, many people took action and climbed the barbed wire fence protecting the mutant crops. About 30 people were ripping the plants from the ground, and six people were arrested. All were released the same day after all being charged with vandalism, one for obstruction, and one was even charged with the theft of a GM plant! Contact Fife EF!

Accountably. Genetix Snowball campaigners targeted 3 sites for their Silent Spring weekend on April 16/17. However, the weekend was somewhat silenter than hoped. AgrEvo was successful in gaining an injunction against six named snowball activists the day before the planned actions. Two of the three targeted sites were heavily guarded by police, the third one had already been covertly decontaminated a few days before by persons unknown. More successfully, an ethical shoplift was carried out in Manchester.

April 19th was another date in the long list of Monsanto's PR balls-ups when their attempt to extend their injunction against the Snowball campaign was rejected by the jury in the London trial. The injunction, if granted, would have prohibited any person who had ever ordered a Snowball handbook to go near any of their fields. Inspections A number of local campaigns have sprung up against specific test sites. Prevented A farmer in Suffolk has withdrawn from GMO testing, due to "protester risk'. Mr Reeve of Riding farm, Walsham le Willows Near Bury St. Edmonds, had a licence to grow GM crops the year, but decided against it because "...I am sure they would have been pulled up."

Up and coming: The first farm size GM trial of oilseed rape has been approved now, on the land of Captain Barker, chum of Prince Charles. The man owns 3000 acres near Hannington, Wiltshire, of which he is offering 100 to the experiment. 23 acres in the centre will be the GM crop. "I don't want to destroy anything, but if I can grow food half price I must look at it" is Mr Barkers justification. Well of course nobody wants to destroy anything, but...can anybody look at it please?

AVON RING ROAD CONTRACT INFO

The contract for building the Avon Ring Road has been awarded to Christiani Nielsen. Their head office is in Learnington Spa and they also have a subsidiary in Cardiff. Research shows they are quite a small company for a contract of this size, so solidarity actions and hitting them hard will be really worthwhile. This company is hated in the West Country. They got the job of the Wells Relief Road in Somerset a few years ago, then followed it up with the nasty evictions on the quarry road through Dead Woman's Bottom on the Mendips. MCLIBEL APPEAL VERDICT

A high court appeal launched by the McLibel Two point: http://sfmhp.pasdex.com.au/war as resulted in significant improvements to the judge's original McLibel verdict. In the appeal decision formally delivered on March 31st, the judges ruled that claims that excessive consumption of burgers enlarges the risk of heart disease, and that their employees get bad pay for work in crap conditions are justified. The appeal judges' ruled that in the light of their revisions of the original verdict, the £60,000 damages awarded to McDonald's should be reduced by £20,000 - which the McLibel crew won't pay anyway. "The appeal verdict's really a pile of shit with two cherries in it," commented Helen. "With a staggering 65 million hits to its credit, the McSpotlight web-site is

BAE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

April 28th saw another successful AGM action from nti-arms trade campaigners. Between 70 and 100 people were carried out after a first bout of major lisruption at the start.

The company decided to persevere with the neeting, and other shareholders asked pertinent uestions of the board for three hours. Campaign gainst the Arms Trade's major scoop centred around contract which BAe has won to run a high explosive production plant in the US. The plant will produce RDX, a component of landmines. Now the US has not signed the Ottowa Convention banning the production of landmines, but CAAT believes that it is illegal under the convention and in British law for a British ompany to be involved in this sort of activity in nother country. BAe's response was that they had no knowledge of the project and so couldn't answer questions about its legality.

Another arms trade company, Alvis, held their AGM on the same day, presumably to avoid protesters. However, it didn't work. Seven people occupied their offices at 8.30 in the morning, catching a bit of more intimate questioning with chairman Nick Press before he left Their building was scaled to hang a banner and there was also a presence inside their AGM Contact: CAAT 0171 281 0297

DIY ANTI-**GLOBALISATION DAY**

A group of around 50 people from a range of packgrounds met in Birmingham on Mayday for an action tour of some of the city's corporate premises. They entered the Natwest HO and went in search of senior managers to ask about their ethical policy in th third world and involvement with vivisectionists Huntingdon Life Sciences. The outside was decorated with posters of animal experiments and scenes of poverty

Eventually everyone was removed from the ouilding and set off into the city centre, accompanied by the sounds of Little Nora sound system being wheeled along in a pushchair. A McDonalds was entered and closed down. Carrying on past Labour party HQ the tour arrived at a Ferrari/Jaguar showroom, which was stickered with anti-car stickers. The police removed people from the building, but four other showrooms on the same street shut up shop for two hours in case they got invaded too. Another drive in McDonalds was shut down and then everyone went to Lee Bank, one of the most deprived estates in Western Europe, to chill out.

The action was really successful at bringing people ogether, and it is hoped that a new direct action group will spring up in Birmingham as a result of it. Contact 0961 810356

WOMEN AGAINST WAR

On April 16, one day after Nato warplanes bombed refugee convoy in the Kosovo war, three women limbed the fence of the RAF base Fairford, from where bombers take off. They unfolded banners with pacifist slogans and tied them to the planes in the presence of American soldiers. Later on they were

dragged off by MOD police, but no arrests were made. Other actions and blockades took place throughout Europe, including a hunger strike in Italy REALITY OF WAR on-line anti-war information

> **ITIOZ DAM / BASQUE** COUNTRY

A protest took place at the Basque regional parliament in Pamplona, Spain against the building of the massively destructive Itoiz dam. The dam, which is being built as part of a wider plan for industrial and tourist development of the region will flood 81 square kilometres. There has been a history of resistance to the project. In 1996, 8 people cut cables across the valley each weighing 140 tonnes, causing untold damage and setting work back by 11 months.

On the 7th April, people from 20 countries chained themselves to metal grills surrounding the parliament building, scaled the side of the building, and hung banners. Parliamentary police yanked people off the windows, cut chains, poked people with scaffold tubes to get them off the façade and mauled people off the balcony. The fire brigade was used to remove people from pillars. 33 people were arrested. Charges and expulsion

proceedings are being brought against them. As one British activist commented "this is not a

local issue, it's a European one. European companies and tourists are the reason this dam is going ahead. The Basques are really keen to network and build international resistance to this project so why not go over and visit" Solidari@s Con Itoiz, Apdo. 2105, 31080 Iruna,

NEW SOCIAL CENTRE FOR LEEDS

On 24th April, a collective drawn from a range of groups in the Leeds area - including Earth First! and Green Action - reclaimed an unused church complex at Leeds University, and established the 'A Spire' autonomous zone.

A key function of the centre is to promote activism through education (workshops, displays etc.) and inspire participation, both in the collective and in direct action. The initial range of facilities include a vegan cafe, bookshop/library area, gig and party room, meditation area, and bike maintenance. There are also facilities for arts and crafts and children's activities. The collective is in touch with a range of local community groups to try and extend these resources and to involve as many people as possible. The university, who own the building, have stated that they will be going to court after the Mayday weekend, but the collective intend resist the eviction if it comes before 10 weeks into the project.

TRIDENT **PLOUGHSHARES 2000**

Seven Scottish Trident Ploughshares activists blockaded the north gate of Faslane Naval Base. They attached themselves to a steel wire which they slung across the gateway with banners reading 'Trident=Genocide'. It took MOD police more than half an hour to remove them, delaying the departure of the nuclear warhead convoy from Coulport to Albemarle

Four protesters held up a Trident nuclear warhead convoy, in Balloch on Loch Lomondside. The convoy was halted for about 20 minutes by people standing in the road whilst others held banners.

MAYHEM AT THE AIRPORT

Last month, the camps at Arthurs Wood and Cedar Wood were thought safe, after pledges from National Trust not to cut any trees during bird nesting season, and to wait for the House of Lords appeal to be heard in late summer. Never to be trusted, the contractors moved in with chainsaws anyway and cut a number of large trees between the camps. Meanwhile sabotage at the runway site continued and caused considerable damage. On April 21, four campers at Arthurs Wood got caught out by between 30 and 40 police in full riot gear to "secure evidence of theft", arresting several people. One person got bailed off site. The cops also ripped benders apart to secure AMEC fence posts, and generally trashed the site. Apparently they used evidence from a video they snatched from a French video team who had filmed the camp. More people have moved back on site since then, and more are needed still.

A55 ANGLESEY

Work on the Euroroute to Dublin has started with hedges being cut down and construction work due to start at the end of April. Tarmac and Laing are the contractors for this 20 mile long DBFO road and you are welcome to visit their local branches near you. Locally, people are fed the usual lies about economic development, which makes setting up camps difficult but days of action might still go ahead. Help with this is needed. PERSIMMON HOMES AGM ACTION

Protesting shareholders were turned away from a luxury housebuilding company's AGM because of what they were wearing. Local residents from the Campaign Against Stevenage Expansion (CASE) had hooked up with activists from URGENT to purchase shares in the company in order to raise their concerns about Persimmon's involvement with the development of the Langley Valley in Hertfordshire and the biggest incursion into Green Belt land in fifty years. The Mayfair hotel where the AGM was held [Wed April 28th] conveniently took exception to the dress of some of the protestors. The AGM was packed with security: men in suits lining the lobbies, cameras recording the event and the first rows full of suits with "Guest" labels on. Referring to their proposals as "Garden City 21", Persimmon continued their desperate attempts to fob off the greenies but sadly, failed to realise that greenwash doesn't work and they need to stop building luxury houses on greenfield sites before the protestors will go away. Once inside the local campaigners kept it cool by

asking sticky questions about the company's environmental record - and why their appearance had been deemed offensive.

With the proposals still at the planning stage, campaigners are getting organised early. There are plans to step up protest if the development goes ahead. URGENT 01865 721366

As revealed on the Mark Thomas show, it is possible for local people to demand a local referendum on any issue of concern to them. And so to coincide with the Euro elections on June 10th, in Devon, Dorset, Buckinghamshire, Derbyshire, Yorkshire, Merseyside, Brighton, Newcastle and

elsewhere people are getting their own referenda together....and it isn't too late to get involved. Under the 1972 local government act it requires six "local government electors" to call a parish meeting. If at this meeting ten electors (or one third of those present whichever is the LEAST) call for a referendum it happens. Quite simple really! FASLANE ACTIONS

To demonstrate their objection to the war the peace campers have been holding a vigil at the gates of the base. H.M.S. Splendid, based at Faslane, is currently firing cruise missiles at Yugoslavia. On May 15th there will be a mass vigil starting at 7:00 pm, which hopefully will turn into a 24-hour vigil.

In a complete divergence from established procedures the new nuclear submarine HMS Vengeance, on its arrival in the Clyde estuary, did not go to its berth at Faslane. It went instead to the base at Coulport, to try and avoid prying eyes and TV cameras. However, protesters left their vigil on the Gareloch and hiked 3 miles across the hillside to get into the waters of Loch Long close to the submarine. At least six people swam out towards Vengeance despite heavy police presence, some of them getting within 100 yards of the vessel. Faslane Peace Camp: 01436 820901

GENETIC CROP SQUAT IN MAY

A camp will be set up to highlight alternatives to corporate based food production, with practical displays and workshops on local food production. The camp will try to link this struggle with other struggles across the globe and include information about June 18th (see insert). It is also timed to coincide with the intercontinental caravan of 500 Indian activists linking struggles through Europe and India. Like all industry, forestry has become dominated by a relatively small number of large multinational companies who are increasingly becoming the only decision makers on a global scale. With US companies venturing south into Latin America, and Scandinavian companies eying up the vast tracts of Russian forests that have been made available to capitalism as the USSR collapsed, the remaining forests of the world are under siege. And this November, a major new weapon may become at the disposal of the corporate elite, as the World Trade Organisation signs its 'Free Logging Agreement'.

The World Trade Organisation

Formed in 1994 as the sister organisation to the IMF and World Bank, the WTO has a mandate to remove any barriers to free trade that member countries might have. Over the last 5 years, the organisation has been gradually negotiating free trade agreements in more and more sectors of the economy. It is the WTO that is introducing sanctions that are causing the current EU-US 'banana war', and the threat of a much larger trade war is one of the main reasons why stopping genetic engineering in its tracks is proving so loss, after deforestation). Free Logging Agreement

This, like all WTO agreements, seeks to eliminate 'tariff' and 'non-tariff' barriers to trade. A tariff is like a tax that a country imposes on a certain import, often to discourage its consumption over what is made at home By eliminating them, prices come down, stimulating consumption. This means the further growth of the forestry industry which is bad news for forests and the ecosystems and communities they support. Whether it's old growth logging or the planting of fast-growing sterile eucalyptus nonocultures, the global timber trade is exceedingly destructive.

the direct social effects, e.g. mass redundancies, when a company pulls out of an area, the threat of disinvestment often encourages countries to drop environmental and social protection legislation in order to maintain competitiveness in the global economy.

Equally disturbing is what could be made illegal as a 'nontariff barrier to trade'. Whatever the WTO decides are 'unreasonably high standards of forest protection' are potentially challengeable by WTO rules Another likely victim of free trade is eco-labelling. The WTO only recognises product labels which indicate how a product performs on the job (ie. as a two-by-four or as pulp for paper). The WTO sees all other kinds of labels as barriers to trade. It is likely that the WTO will accuse certification and ecolabelling such as Forest Stewardship Council's international scheme of certifying sustainably produced timber of violating WTO trade laws.

As the volume of forest product trade increases, so do the chances of alien species invasions. Exotic beetles, moths, fungi, and other pests often "hitchhike" on international shipments of wood products that have not been processed or treated with chemicals and fumigants. When imported into a country where forest ecosystems do not have natural immunities against these pests, large-scale infestations, disease and destruction result (this phenomena, known as bioinvasion, is currently the second largest cause of species on wood being chemically treated before import to rid it of destructive pests, but it is likely that these regulations will also be declared barriers to trade under the new agreement. WTO agreements usually stipulate that the least trade restrictive of all import restrictions must be the only acceptable policy for governments to take

The Investment Agenda

As well as the forest products agreement, expect a new 'Millennium Round' of WTO talks to be announced at Seattle. This will be a vast extension of the WTO's powers, in effect a resurrection of the MAI, the investment treaty that was defeated last autumn. This will of course affect all areas of life, but to stick with the effect on forests

Firstly, investors will be granted equal rights, regardless of which country they come from. Therefore foreign multinationals can buy up forests around the world, and if they are designated as indigenous or nature reservations then they have the cash and power to challenge that designation and ensure they get the right verdict. Also, investing companies would be able to challenge governments if they believed they had introduced egulations which denied the company profits which were rightfully theirs - this means if a government were to bring in new environmental standards they would have to
