Subj: RENAME AND MODIFY MISSIONS FOR NAVY MARINE CORPS
INTELLIGENCE CENTER, VIRGINIA BEACH, VA AND FLEET
INTELLIGENCE TRAINING COMMAND, SAN DIEGO, CA

1. Purpose. To approve the renaming and mission modification for Navy Marine Corps Intelligence Center (NMITC), Virginia Beach, VA and Fleet Intelligence Training Command (FITC), San Diego, CA, per reference (a).

2. Background. This action revises the mission statements and activity names for the two commands to better identify the scope of responsibility of the commands and to standardize their names with all other Center for Information Dominance (CENINFODOM) subordinate activities. There are no changes to current manning or to facilities occupied by these commands.

rename and revise the mission of NMITC and FITC as stated above.


b. Master Update Authority, Honolulu, HI will revise the
