

One-World Code Words Foreshadow Trouble for Bible Believers

Code words are emerging pointing to the one-world system envisioned by Bible prophecy. A new Ambassador-at-Large for Religious Freedom has been appointed by the U.S. President. David Saperstein is the first Jew to hold the position and wasted no time identifying some of the current threats to religious freedom such as the rising anti-Muslim and anti-Semitic sentiment in Western Europe and the purging of the Christians in Islamic countries.

One of Saperstein's goals stated in his acceptance speech was to "help in shaping policies that contribute to isolating and delegitimizing *extremist religious voices*." (Emphasis added)

Another voice attempting to speak to the problem of religious freedom is for-

In India, a Window is Closing

India appears to be nearing a change that may seriously affect the gospel. The recent election of a hardline Hindu president is encouraging attacks on both Christians and Muslims by Hindus. Anti-conversion laws are being passed in many areas.

When we look at the foreign mission field, certain areas are more open to the gospel at any given time. For example, the Philippines has been wide open for several years and tracts have been flooded there numbering in the millions.

Other areas, such as China and Muslim-dominated countries, are

The event hatred for the Jews fostered occurred during a meeting of the Student by Roman Catholicism's "Replacement Government Council who was voting on Theology." For centuries, Rome has claimed

a Boycott, Divestment, and Sanctions (BDS) resolution.

BDS is a world-wide, pro-Palestinian (thus: anti-Israel) movement seeking to damage the Israeli economy. It has chapters on campuses to pressure the university trust funds to boycott Israeli businesses and investments.

After the walkout, the Student Council voted 8 to 2 in favor of the resolution to boycott and divest, much to the satisfac-

tion of the pro-Hamas group Students for Justice in Palestine (SJP) who had championed the vote. Jewish leaders and their friends on campus knew the situation was serious when a couple of swastikas were painted on a Jewish frat house a few days later.

UC Davis leaders said that the student resolution does not affect their investment strategies which are set by the UC Regents. Nevertheless, this is only one example of a global effort to discredit Israel's right to exist. BDS goals are the return of all Palestinian lands to Arab control and the dismantling of the wall that Israel has built to keep out suicide bombers. Of course, if done,

"Jewish problem."



Church Leaders Worried Over Drop in Baptisms

For decades, the Southern Baptists have tracked baptisms in their churches as a way to measure the effectiveness of their witnessing. Their leaders are becoming concerned as the numbers have been steadily dropping over the last decade.

As the world becomes more "worldly," witnessing is becoming more rare. While demand for gospel tracts is rising in foreign mission fields, usage in the U.S. is dropping. For more than a century, Europe has been a more difficult mission field than Africa or Latin America. As America drifts politically and culturally toward Europe, the gospel finds less and less fertile soil here.

One encouraging sign found by Barna Research is that the coming generation of 18 to 30-year-olds, known as Millennials, seems to be reversing the trend. Some 65 percent of born-again Millennials shared the gospel in 2013, compared to 56 percent in 2010.

A study by Southern Baptist leadership found a serious lack of a sense of urgency to reach the lost. As a result, few Christians bother to spend time with unbelievers. This has allowed popular opinion in the culture to shift against Bible believers, casting them more by what they are against than what they are for. Satan has successfully labeled Bible believers as judgmental, homophobic, hate mongers.

As a result, many who "name the name of

Christ" have switched from sharing the gospel openly, to more incognito roles hoping no one discovers their true identity right away. Leaders are recommending a more subtle approach of "relationship evangelism." Only after establishing a "relationship," does one attempt to "evangelize." Unfortunately, this is

not working out very well, because Christian "fellowships" have become more and more inbred, with little contact with unbelievers. Members concentrate on "fellowship" with other believers, seldom inviting unbe-

lievers into the circle. This has all contributed to a loss of concern for those around us who, in reality, are on their way to hell.

Part of the world's complaint about Bible believers being judgmental has some merit, when we approach them without the "joy of the Lord" in our attitude. If they fail to see that we are genuinely living an "abundant life," how can they develop a thirst for the Living Water that we are offering? When

ments of this world are "secular," opting out of taking sides on spiritual issues. This leaves them defenseless against nations or movements that are fanatical about a spiritual mission.

In February of 1981, Time Magazine described a controversy about a United Church of Christ (UCC) minister named Mansfield Kaseman, who wanted to be ordained Presbyterian. They asked him.

"Was Jesus God?"

Kaseman answered. God is God." That's kind of obvious But is Jesus Christ God? He refused to say that.

Okay, the guy is a heretic. Get rid of him! But no, after fierce debate, the majority decided to ordain him a Presbyterian minister anyway. What would cause a guy to think that Jesus wasn't actually God? It couldn't be the Bible that he read, could it?

Well, let me tell you about something that had once made me think that maybe Jesus was NOT the Creator, after all. You won't believe how tiny it was. Just one single word. Want to know what it was?

I graduated Bible college as a top Greek student. I tested right into Advanced Greek at Fuller Seminary. That would make a person think I really knew something. But all I knew is what I was taught. Think about it: who says my professors and Greek books got it right? And how do I know?

But the meaning of a single tiny word in a well-known verse got me to think that Jesus Christ was not the Creator, I started to think of Him more as a "middle man."

Please look at John 1:3: "All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made." Seems

> simple enough. "All things were made by him..."

> What does that make Jesus? The Creator! Even a 5 year old can tell you that. That is the reading (and I checked it for myself) of every English Bible I could find through history, from Wycliffe in 1384 clear into the 1800s.

> They all say: "All things were made BY HIM."

In 1870, a huge Greek interlinear was published, called the

Emphatic Diaglott. In it they made this tiny change. Suddenly, all things weren't made "BY" Him. Now, all things were made "THROUGH" Him. It's not rocket science. If all things are only created THROUGH Him, Jesus isn't the Creator anymore. He's just the middle man.

If God the Father is Creator, Jesus didn't

we hand someone a no-nonsense gospel tract, our face must show the genuine joy that we are living and an earnest compassion for that individual. But we must give them the tract, because in our busy lives there is little opportunity to spend time building a "relationship" before sharing the gospel.

So many Bible believers have kind of given up, recognizing that time does not permit reaching the world through a

lengthy relationship process. We bemoan that the world seems to be "going to hell in a hand basket," and petition God for revival. But we must not forget that saturations with no-nonsense gospel tracts played major roles in past national revivals.

Tract blitzing is something we can all be involved in and Chick Publications has hundreds of letters and e-mail testifying to the power of the scriptures imbedded in Chick tracts.

much harder and getting tracts in sometimes takes some Holy Ghost strategy. Other countries are unstable and often a window of opportunity may open or close on short notice.

For a long time Chick Publications has found it difficult to print here and ship literature into India because of customs barriers. To overcome this, a national printer agreed to take our printing files and fill orders in the country. He is also able to introduce us to ministries who are most able to use tracts in significant quantities.

Now, with the rising persecution, ministries are issuing urgent pleas for literature while they can still use them. We have been notified of three ministries who have found ways to effectively use large quantities of tracts.

One of them does what they call "guerrilla evangelism." They use roving teams who camp for a few days near a local church and fan out into the community, quickly putting literature in every home and praying with those who are willing. Then they pack up and disappear leaving the church to disciple those who have

responded to the saturation effort. Done quietly, under the radar of the authorities, these teams get out 20,000 to 40,000 gospel tracts a month.

The other two ministries conduct hundreds of Vacation Bible Schools at local churches. They supply tracts and other teaching materials to the churches and guidance in attracting and disciplining the neighborhood children who are mostly Hindu and Muslim backgrounds.

Over 5,000 churches in North India are served by one of these ministries

helping them conduct more than a thousand VBSs a year. They are requesting a minimum of 100,000 tracts.

Chick Publications' contact writes that the government is actively striving to make conversion to Christ a crime: "They are trying to get anti-conversion laws passed across India and very likely they will come in force because of the overwhelming majority of the

Hindutva crowd. "So we need to use the time available to us to make the best use of time while we still can. They are also curbing the media from reporting attacks against Christians, so a lot of these persecutions are not even getting media coverage. Last week, one of the Christian pastors was picked up by Naxalites in Chattisgarh and tortured and beheaded. The pastor was 32 years old. None of the main-line media covered it. Not even a mention of it. So no protest or hue or cry."

These are examples of missions organizations who have found a way, by reaching the children and operating in the shadows of the growing darkness in India. While the window is open, it is still possible to saturate whole areas with gospel literature in the local languages. They have requested a total of 380,000 tracts as soon as possible. The first 80,000 has been completed, and work has begun on the next 100.000 for children in VBS programs. 

In another quote, it is clear that the pope equates his despised ideological Christians with someone else he hates: fundamentalists

On June 13, 2014, he said: "A fundamentalist group, although it may not kill anyone, although it may not strike anyone, is violent. The mental structure of fundamentalists is violence in the name of God."

On November 30, 2014, he said: "You ... can't say that all Christians are fundamentalists. We have our share of them (fundamentalists). All religions have these little groups." So, if an ideology is a belief system, then the pope is saying that these bad "ideological Christians" are anyone who disagrees with him.

All these voices are talking up a world with "open minded and stable societies," using Blair's terms. This is a utopia where "we all just get along." 
Little Mary served faithful unto the end. I hope what Mary did might inspire you also.
