⁴ Individual Members are defined as:

A) For organizations that are primary co-operatives, individual members refer to the number of members the organization has. This membership number is defined in the by-laws of the organization and can include individual persons, families, policy-holders, or enterprises such as farms or businesses.

B) If the organization is a representative organization for co-operatives (apex), individual members are the aggregated total number as described in A above that all the apex organization's direct members represent (including "members of members", all the way down until the end unit is reached in A above), regardless of whether or not the direct members are themselves members of ICA or pay a contribution to ICA.
