


Shannonwatch records and documents flights by the US military and its contractors in and out of Shannon Airport.

The U.S. military have been using Shannon Airport on an ongoing basis since 2002. The aircraft recorded there include:

- U.S. troop carriers (Omni Air International, World Airways, North American Airlines);
- U.S. Air Force and Navy planes, including C-130 Hercules, C-17's, in-flight refueling aircraft, executive jets, and Boeing 737's;
- U.S. registered cargo planes operated by airlines with military contracts. These include Evergreen International, Kalitta Air, Murray Air (now National Air Cargo).

Shannon Airport has also been used repeatedly over the years by CIA rendition planes. These were used to transfer individuals from one country to another by means that bypassed all judicial and administrative due process.

Between 2003 and 2009 hundreds of rendition-linked flights passed through Shannon. Shannonwatch have identified 22 known or suspected rendition aircraft that were using the airport in that period.

Garda have been asked on many occasions to search rendition-linked aircraft and to confirm if military planes are carrying illegal or undeclared munitions. However **no proper inspections have been carried out**.
