**CC:**

**Can a Nevada prison sentence become a death sentence? We think, yes, it can.**

Two Nevada Inmate Death Lists: (See Enclosed.)

- a) 09-08-1905 to 04-13-2000
- b) 01/01/2000 to 06/04/2007

No deaths? Or no deaths reported, in Nevada prisons 1913 – 1924==11 years?

No deaths from natural causes? Or none reported 03-03-1930 to 11-21-1953==23 years?

Inmate Death List a), precludes data analysis because it appears to be incomplete.

The data on Inmate Death List b)... January 2000 to June 2007 is not up to date... 17 months behind. But we hope to receive current, correct, data shortly, to have complete data to study.

We are requesting NV prison inmate death data that can hopefully reveal:

- 1) The average time inmates were in NV prisons until they died;
- 2) The average age at death;
- 3) The average time in NV prisons before death by race.
- 4) The average time inmates were in NV prisons before their deaths
- 5) The population of prison deaths per thousand compared to the NV general population.

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It appears that the most recent 11 deaths in NV prisons (March to May 2007) list "Natural" as the reason for death. Have prisoner autopsies stopped? Why is this data so difficult to keep current?

It is reported that Mr. Guy W. Martens had no prior felonies and that he came to prison in NV in a wheelchair going directly into the Regional Medical Facility in Carson City.

For your consideration, we offer an account of the NV prison medical experience from Mr. Martens in 2001 and an account in 2008. Both are "white collar crime" prisoners. Both suggest that improvement in prisoner care may not be progressing so quickly as prisoners, families, advocates and proponents of true justice in NV would wish.

Mr. Guy W. Martens' penned letters to us asking for help for himself and others in NDOC Regional Medical Facility in Carson City. The name of the second correspondent is being withheld.

(NOTE: If you care to read the entire contents of these gut wrenching letters, please advise. We can provide copies of them for you, if you can assure no retaliation will occur.)

**I received your letter of 12-10-00 today. 36 days after you mailed it to me. You addressed it right and the delay was no fault of yours. This is just one way they mentely [sic] abuse us here. I am writing this letter to you hoping [sic] you might be able to help us who suffer here at N.N.C.C.**

**I am a big man. 6' 3" and 334 pounds. In my younger years I was a football player. In 1989 I suffered a heart attack that left me with sever [sic] medical problems and now in a wheelchair. Becouse [sic] of a involuntary bankrupcy [sic] my company had some N.S.F. checks out that I could not cover...**

**So, because [sic] of my health I could not work. And the judge sayed [sic] he felt prison best for me. I received the max sentence five years. After sentencing, I was taken to N.N.C.C. R. M. F. = Regional Medical Facility. Becouse I did not go through normal intake - fish tank. I was unable to get a compleat [sic] issue of clothing in my size. I was finally issued 1 woren [sic] out shirt. To this day, I still don't have a second shirt to change into so that I might wash the one I have...**

**I have been forced to wash my cloths [sic] in the cell tolet [sic] and then remain naked and cold for hours because [sic] the prison has no cloths [sic] for me. I have endured ridicule and teasing by some female staff regaurding [sic] my nakedness and large size. I have tryed [sic] to complain, but my complaints have fallen on deaf ears. In fact, when I tryed [sic] to complain the luentent [sic] cut me off with a threat of disiplinary [sic] sactions [sic]...**

**I have given a lot of thought to how I might help you help others. I feel I can best do by giving you as much information as I can from the inside. Brutality, inhumane medical treatment and timekeeping problems are big problems and issues here...**

**Brutality has many faces in the Nevada prison system. I have seen men come in here from camp with a broken leg and bone sickness that will not heal after being cleared by Indian Springs medical staff for N. D. F. now this young man will never walk right again. This man was placed in the RMF and was forgotten about for almost 6 months. The man lost 120 days of work and camp time that he can never earn back...**

**I watched medical staff remove a man who had died from a heart attack in a isolation cell be taken out on a gurney and hit with high voltage from the heart paddles. The body jumped so high that it fell right off of the gurney onto the floor. I heard the medical staff say (Gee that**

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was fun. Should we do it again) Question - Why would anyone be left in a locked isolation room with a severe heart condition and no way to contact staff or anyone else...

I have personally been shorted my cardiac medication, no less than 10 times in a period of between 10-7-2000 and 1-27-2001. Sometimes I have received my medication late. But other times I have not received it at all. These meds are life-threatening to me if I don't get them...

I have personally witnessed nursing staff at the RMF take over an hour to insert a simple IV. And then when the IV was started the IV needle was severely bent in the patient's vein [sic]. The same man that endured the bent IV needle was disconnected from the IV and blood dripped all over the cell floor. And all over this man's bed. We were all exposed to the open bent needle for hours. Also all the body fluids [sic]. The man was forced to lay in his own blood for over four days. We requested clean sheets and cleaning supplies, but were refused by forensic X...

General cruelty [sic]... sick people are punished just for being sick... the NDOP places them in the RMF and that person loses time he or she can never earn back. This unfair treatment costs taxpayers million [sic] of dollars per year and causes hard feelings between inmates and inmates + staff. There are fights over this almost every day. THIS SUBJECT NEEDS ATTENTION!! I can't stress this enough...

Forensics X and Y... (He wrote the actual names.) have taken my personal oxygen wrench for my tank so I can't turn my oxygen tank on or off any more. They also had my doctors [sic] diet canceled. They took my Nitro pills and other meds. I still have not been able to get them back. By these actions they have jeopardized my life. These people are only forensics and not medical staff. They are custody staff only... END.

As I recall, I called NDOC to see what had happened to Mr. Martens, only to learn that had been shipped out of state. We never heard from him again. Did he have family? We don't know and have been unable to find out. Mr. Martens is listed as dead 04/28/2003. (See Inmate Death List.)

Is this not a double tragedy if he had no family to speak for him... and our mail not delivered to him, as we have experienced. Our letters have been returned to us checked "Unauthorized...", why we do not know. We want to make things better for all.

This second letter is current (2008), from a minimum security inmate. Excerpts:

... I started having chest pains at around 11 AM... I thought the pain would pass, yet as the day went by it only got worse... I notified officer X, who was working in the office that my chest was hurting... Officer X asked me questions concerning the location of the pain and symptoms, I explained that my chest was hurting, throbbing in my left arm around the elbow, jaw pain and some back pain. All signs of a heart attack...

I then asked him to call the ambulance... the pain was, at this time, unbearable. Officer X screamed that if I continued with my claims of chest pain, I'd be taken to the hole... in pain, yet not wanting to get into trouble, I remained persistent, asking again for emergency medical assistance...

Clearly angry, Officer X, who then acted as if I was lying and gave me a direct order to return my bunk, (which I did), where I was to await further instructions. About an hour later and after count, holding my chest and in pain, barely able to walk, I returned to the officer's office, again asking for help, that seem to upset officer X. Further, I was told to return to my bunk, again I followed the order given...

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About an hour later officer X2 came to my bunk with a green duffel bag and informed me that I was to be transported to XXX. Rather than the local hospital, since XXX was a two-hour drive. I became very afraid, thinking I wouldn't survive the trip, and as I expressed these concerns to officer X2, who also became mad and upset, it became clear to me that he didn't care, stating he was just doing his job.

I asked for help and packing my belongings and was denied, the officer stating it wasn't his job to help me pack or carry my things. I was told to take my belongings to the front gate, (a few other inmates helped me, who will be named later) and there I got into a pickup truck and was transported to...

I was taken to the infirmary a short time later due to my complaints, and in a room with a male and female nurse who began to treat me. In the room above my head was a large poster explaining where to place the electrodes for the EKG on my chest, I couldn't help but notice it because the male nurse kept referring to it, after the female nurse informed the male nurse that he had hooked up the electrodes in the wrong position.

After reading the printout, the male nurse informed me that my chest was fine and that he could see nothing wrong.

I was then given a shot for pain which had no effect, (I was told it was like having a IBU on steroids.) And then I was taken to a cell in the infirmary. I remained in pain, and shortly thereafter, everything went black. I awoke about 40 minutes later, (I could see a clock on the wall in the hallway).

I was still in pain, so I hit the emergency button on the wall, and told the officer I was still in pain, and needed further help, a few minutes later I was told to get dressed, and that I'd be taken to an outside hospital. I was in the cell for a total of about 2 hours.

Officers came to my cell, cuffed my hands and legs, and walked me to a transportation van and proceeded to take me to the local outside hospital... it was dark, raining, the trip took about an hour.

Once I got to the hospital, a male nurse began to treat me, giving me Nitro tablets and morphine, only then did the pain (for the first time in hours) stop. The male nurse looked at the EKG tape (or paper), which was done at the prison infirmary and began to explain that I'd had a massive heart attack, he said he couldn't understand how the prisoner nurse could have missed that fact, since the tape clearly showed it.

He then called the prison and asked the nurse how such a mistake could have been made, clearly upset, he hung up the phone, and again, began working on me.

At dawn, the next morning, I was care flighted from the local hospital to... I was placed in room X of the cardiac care unit, and the next day was taken to the cardiac catheterization laboratory, where I received angioplasty and two stent placement procedures, I was told by Dr. X. that I had a 97% blockage in my arteries.

At night, the nurse told me that my medication would be doubled and needed for life, when I asked her to explain why, she said that during my first procedure a artery had been torn and the procedure had to be stopped due to bleeding, that I would again have another procedure done in the morning, for my third and fourth stent placement.

I was, at all times, under guard during my stay at XXX and on this occasion my guard heard this conversation and agreed to testify on my behalf if called upon. I spent around nine

days in the cardiac care unit, I was then moved to XXX, where I was in the prison infirmary for 17 days. I now have four stents in my arteries and six different medications, which I take daily for life...

My treatment was delayed, my heart condition went untreated, which caused further unrepairable [sic] permanent damage to my heart muscle.

The longer the heart goes without treatment, blood flow, the more damage done, and cannot be repaired, how much damage was done is unknown since I've been denied any outside follow-up tests or further treatment (as was ordered by Dr. X at blank). Even getting my medication refills monthly is a struggle.

This medical situation is ongoing. The continued mistreatment varies from institution to institution. END.

Today a former NV corrections officer told me that there are people who should not be working in prisons. A second officer recently told me that he did not like working with the "heavy badgers" and was proud that he had never put a hand on a prisoner in the many years he worked there. He said that if prisoners told him they needed medical, that he made sure they got help right away. Both have bad memories of NV prisons. Both are the kind of officers that NV prisons desperately need.

Not everybody in prison is guilty, nor violent, nor lost. Most need medical care for drug addiction. All, however, deserve compassion. After health comes the ability to learn, to be independent.

If we do not extend a helping hand to them, how will they learn to understand others and to become compassionate human beings themselves?

How many more nonviolent, minimum security inmates' sentences will turn into death sentences this year and next, because of the way NDOC personnel reportedly mishandle medical emergencies? Only time will tell... and time is the essence of life for them... and for us all.

How many others, no matter the nature of their crimes, are receiving or have received NV death sentences through medical neglect, abuse and malpractice in the State of Nevada? Court cases are brewing, coming through NV courts daily, costing taxpayers much more than the decent treatment that could have been extended.

Will you please recommend a complete audit of NV prison medical and medical emergency classes in standards and correct procedures for corrections officers?

Another issue that stands out after reviewing the INMATE DEATHS REPORT REPORT #2.9 (01/01/2000 to 06/04/2007) is the number of prisoners who died shortly after entering NDOC:

Would you kindly recommend an investigation on the above prisoners to find out why these prisoners 1) were not receiving proper counseling to prevent suicides and 2) how we can get better medical treatment to save prisoners' lives... in fully accredited prison hospital facilities.

The State of Nevada keeps no record of former prisoners who receive Medicaid, according to the Health Policy office. This data would be good to have. But, if we keep prisoners healthy and educate them, there will be less taxpayer money to spend on Medicaid after they leave prison.

Will you please recommend a timekeeping audit by volunteer ombudsmen?

How many typos are there in timekeeping records throughout NDOC? Thousands and thousands that affect thousands of prisoners? Time credits must not be taken because prisoners suffer illness. This is cruel at best, criminal at worst. Will you step forward and recommend that volunteer ombudsmen loosen this timekeeping gridlock debate and put to rest questions of the correct amounts of time that prisoners must serve?

The bottom line, Commission members, is that NDOC has had no outside oversight, and currently has no outside oversight and no regulating authorities since its inception in 1905 who require NDOC officials to operate to even very minimum standards.

What if this were true of NV schools and hospitals? Taking mature responsibility for human lives, wards of the state, is correct action. Punishing prisoners with death who reach out for help for themselves and others is a morally bankrupt, unacceptable social and governmental policy, in our opinion. Let's reach higher.

Will you please recommend appointing (2) volunteer ombudsmen for each NDOC facility to begin fact finding, with assurance of no retaliation toward prisoners who come forward to report errors and abuses?

Again, will you please recommend that the NV State Health Officer be granted authority over the Nevada Department of Corrections and that inspections occur in each prison yearly, with 60 days to correct deficiencies? The money for these operations must come first because health care in prison is the foundation of sanity and an advancing civilization.

Will you please recommend that all NDOC facilities begin accreditation to minimum standards through the American Correctional Association, This is long, long overdue.

We are not indifferent to the suffering of NDOC staff, whose lives are also impacted negatively by the heavy badgers among them, the scenes of neglect and lack of dedication to excellence in job performance.

To those who have lost their jobs in Nevada prisons (See Encl. LA Times Article) because they objected to the lack of medical care for prisoners, we extend acknowledgement and appreciation. Please recommend that these highly conscious human beings get back their jobs. We need their shining examples before prisoners so that they can learn to care again.

We know that many current staff members work for better conditions so that they can live long and well, too, and that they continue to try to make things better for all inside prison. Yes, operating to standards means the difference between success and failure for everyone in the NV prison system. All can benefit from accreditation.

It is time... before more NDOC inmates die, before more wrongful death lawsuits enter the courts and before federal intervention arrives to clean up NDOC officials' operations, an inevitable consequence if they continue to deny decent health care for prisoners in NV facilities. Health care first! Good things will follow. Without it, they cannot.

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The answer to this enormous, draining social failure, in our opinion, is support, support, support and education, education, education. But, Commission members, I know that, in your hearts, you already knew this.



# Poor medical care cited at Nevada prison

When Nevada death row inmate Charles Randolph asked for a specific medicine to address his heart condition earlier this year, Max Carter, the prison's physician assistant, sent a curt reply: The medication was the wrong kind and potentially lethal, but he would be happy to prescribe it "so that your chances of expiring sooner are increased."

When another prisoner, John O. Snow, asked for pills in July to ease the pain from his deteriorating joints, Carter's denial came with another stinging missive, stating that he was "gonna let you suffer."

To many prison observers, Carter's responses exemplify the callous indifference custody officials at the maximum-security Ely State Prison have for sick prisoners. There has been no staff doctor to handle the medical needs of any the 1,000 inmates here for more than 18 months. Carter is the highest-ranking medical worker at the men's prison; the last staff doctor was a gynecologist.

According to interviews and records obtained by The Times, prisoners at Ely have been denied care for heart problems, diabetes and other serious medical conditions. Earlier this year, a nurse was fired after complaining about substandard care at the facility, which she said led to one inmate needlessly dying of gangrene.

Attorneys for some Ely inmates say they believe the lack of medical care has played a role in a high percentage of death row inmates giving up their appeals and "volunteering" to be executed. All but two of 12 inmates executed in the state in the last 30 years have been volunteers. No other state in the country has had close to that percentage of volunteers, records show.

Recently, the American Civil Liberties Union's National Prison Project has taken up the cause at Ely. ACLU attorneys Amy Fettig and Margaret Winter have met with corrections officials and pressed for reforms to improve inmate care.

A doctor working with the ACLU was granted access to 35 inmates and their medical records in October, and he came to a stark conclusion.

"The medical care provided at Ely State Prison amounts to the grossest possible medical malpractice, and the most shocking and callous disregard for human life and human suffering that I have ever encountered in my 35 years of practice," Dr. William K. Noel said in a report sent Wednesday to Howard Skolnik, director of the Nevada Department of Corrections.

"It is highly unlikely that these 35 cases are aberrations," Noel wrote. "These cases show a system that is so broken and dysfunctional that, in my opinion, every one of the prisoners at Ely ... who has serious medical needs,

or who may develop serious medical needs, is at enormous risk."

Skolnik said Wednesday he had not seen Noel's report and could not comment on any specific allegations. However, he added: "I do know that I have recently been informed through some other auditing that the access to medical care and the quality of care provided by the department meets or exceeds community standards."

An attorney who represents the corrections department said she could not comment, as did an assistant to prison warden E.K. McDaniel.

Max Carter did not respond to messages left for him at the prison's medical department.

Dr. Steven MacArthur, the obstetrician-gynecologist who was the prison's last staff doctor, said it was difficult to treat inmates with severe psychological problems and who cursed and spat at staff. Some prisoners refused to visit the infirmary simply because they couldn't smoke there, he said. Nonetheless, he said, they were well cared for.

"Most inmates age in dog years. They beat the hell out of themselves," he said. "They have lots of aches and pains."

In his report, Noel said he found instances of prisoners being denied medical attention despite suffering from seizures, syphilis, deep vein thrombosis and rheumatoid arthritis. He acknowledged that many Ely prisoners "have committed horrible crimes" but said physicians took an oath to make "no judgments as to character or morality" when treating a patient.

Under a 1976 Supreme Court decision, based on the 8th Amendment's prohibition against cruel and unusual punishment, government officials are obliged "to provide medical care for those whom it is punishing by incarceration."

In a letter accompanying Noel's report, ACLU attorneys Fettig and Winter asked the director of corrections to set up a meeting with Gov. Jim Gibbons because the "medical crisis" at the prison goes far beyond the lack of a doctor and it "seems unrealistic to expect" the department "to summon the resources to resolve the problems without the assistance of the governor and the Legislature."

The facility, which opened in 1989, is more than 250 miles from the state's population and power centers: Reno, Las Vegas and capital Carson City, where executions take place. It handles the day-to-day medical needs of prisoners, but if inmates experience serious ailments, like chest pains, they are sent to a local hospital; life-threatening cases, such as stabbing victims, are airlifted to a larger city.

The prison sits about a dozen miles outside its namesake's downtown.

The prison's desolation — a source of frustration to inmate families and defense attorneys — is part of its appeal to the 4,000-person town, said Mayor Jon Hickman. The facility is easy to ignore, he said. It also provides hundreds of secure jobs to a city whose economy is tied to the tumultuous mining industry.

In this setting, inmate advocates say, corrections officials have denied prisoners needed antibiotics, pain pills and surgeries with little outcry because no local groups exist to do so. When a nurse who had worked at the prison for nearly a decade spoke out, she was forced to scrub the infirmary floor with a toothbrush, court papers say.

That nurse, Lorraine Memory, said in an interview that the prison's dozen or so medical staffers lacked equipment, including an IV pump and a blood pressure monitoring machine, that were particularly helpful during a medical trauma. Little training is provided to the staff, some of whom struggle to use a defibrillator, said Memory, who was eventually fired.

Jewel Jacques, a nurse who has worked at Ely since 1993, and two other prison staffers have signed declarations backing up Memory's account of prison conditions.

Most inmates complaining of pain are given only a handful of Tylenol a week, Jacques said.

Relatives of some inmates say prisoners with minor ailments often avoid the infirmary, convinced that Ely's medical staff would either ignore or harm them.

Inmate Snow, who is on death row for the 1983 contract killing of a Las Vegas nightclub owner, has no cartilage in his hips, but was given no painkillers to cope with bones that scrape against one another, Noel's report said. Instead, the prisoner was prescribed Indocin, whose side effects are so severe that the anti-inflammatory medication is mainly used on horses.

At Noel's suggestion, Dr. Robert Bannister, medical director of the state corrections department, changed Snow's medication. But the doctor is still balking at allowing Snow to have hip surgery, Noel wrote. Without it, the inmate will eventually be unable to move, Noel said.

Bannister did not return calls seeking comment.

Such cases frustrate medical staff who said their superiors had long shrugged at inmate suffering because they were concerned about the costs of treatment, according to court papers.

In a complaint to the federal Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, Memory alleged that two diabetic prisoners were denied insulin because MacArthur "wanted to hasten the demise of these two inmates in order to save money or cause them more pain and suffering."

MacArthur denied the allegations.

One of the diabetics, Patrick Cavanaugh, likely suffered from dementia after three years without insulin, according to Noel's report.

Cavanaugh, a former manager for the rock group the Coasters, was on death row for shooting to death one of the group's singers, mutilating his body and dumping it in a canyon.

In prison, Cavanaugh developed gangrene, Memory wrote, and his "toes and feet turned black and this gradually progressed up the legs until it had turned into a stinking, rotting, oozing mess of dead flesh which had reached clear up the level of his knees."

Cavanaugh's medical records, however, described his condition as cellulitis, which Noel said was akin to calling "9/11 a high-rise fire."

MacArthur said Cavanaugh refused oxygen and was never denied insulin. If he was not given it, it was because Cavanaugh declined it, the doctor said.

Cavanaugh died in April 2006; his death certificate was signed by a doctor who had not seen the body and lists "natural causes" as the reason, Memory said.

A month later, state officials fired MacArthur — but not because nurses and other prison employees charged that he provided poor or negligent care. Rather, corrections officials said, it was because MacArthur refused to give up his full-time job at the local hospital, though there was no evidence that it caused him to neglect his prison duties.

MacArthur said the dismissal was unmerited. In a letter to his private practice patients he said that he "was responsible for saving the taxpayers of this state \$1 million per year."

In an interview with The Times this week, MacArthur said he was proud of care he provided to prisoners, but acknowledged limits on what the medical staff would treat.

"We didn't cater to every rash and boo-boo that you'd run to your mommy and get kissed," he said.
