## No Means Tests and Market Rents

The Conservative Government, claiming to be the party of 'hard working blue collar workers', is threatening huge rent rises for working tenants of Councils or housing associations. Any household earning more than a total £30,000 a year, or £40,000 in London, is threatened with doubling or tripling rents to 'market' level, forcing people out of their homes and communities. Existing council rents are not 'subsidised' as Ministers falsely claim; council rents are lower because they are not based on maximised profits. Tenants did not cause the economic crash and austerity, but are being asked to pay for it.

Charging market rents for working households would:

- \*deter members from work, promotion or overtime, undermining the idea of 'mixed communities'
- \* force affected households to move, or take in lodgers and intensify overcrowding.
- \* Push some to consider Right to Buy leaseholding, though most can not afford this even with maximum discount
- \* as with the Poll Tax, push many off the rent book, and create further conflict as tenants refuse to declare income and challenge landlords' powers to force disclosure

## We will:

Campaign with tenants and trade unions to expose and challenge this policy call on councillors and MPs to oppose it

call on council and housing association landlords to actively oppose it: no spying on tenants support action to resist this attack

support members to campaign on housing problems, to link up and defend the right to secure homes we can afford
