THE VISIT WAS EXTREMELY PRODUCTIVE AS THE CINC HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO MEET WITH PRESIDENT GAVIRIA, MINISTER OF DEFENSE PARDO AND THE COMMANDERS OF THE ARMED FORCES. AMBASSADOR BUSBY ACCOMPANIED THE CINC CONFIDENTIAL

THE CINC SAID THAT WE WERE PROVIDING SUPPORT TO COLOMBIA AND OUR EFFORTS WERE GENERATING GOOD INTEL. THE TRAFFICKERS ARE DAILY VIOLATING COLOMBIAN SOVEREIGNTY ON THE ROADS, RIVERS AND IN THE AIR. OUR DISRUPTION EFFORTS ARE HAVING AN EFFECT BUT WE MUST KEEP UP THE MOMENTUM. HE SAID THAT EACH OPERATION HAD AN IMPACT; SOME OF THESE INTANGIBLE, SUCH AS THE EFFECT OF PETROLERA ON TRAFFICKING OPERATIONS IN BOLIVIA.
