24	designated an original TOP SECRET classification authority under Executive Order No. 12958, as		
25	amended. In the course of my official duties, I have been informed about this lawsuit, the issues

2	dated June 16, 2006, the Director of National Intelligence, John D. Negroponte, has asserted the
