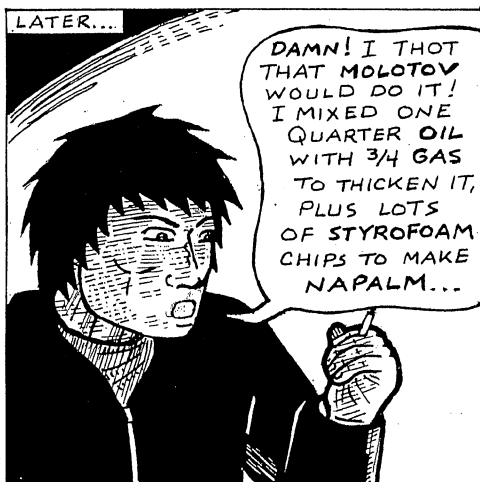
Ecological Destruction: Despite claims to be the “greenest Olympics” ever, the 2010 Olympics will be among the most environmentally destructive in history!



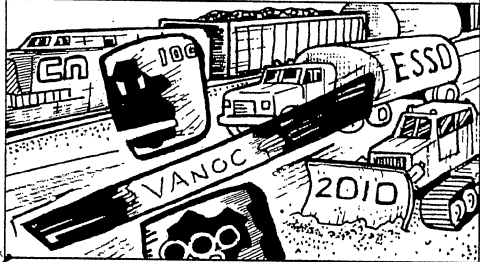
Homelessness: Since winning the 2010 Winter Games in 2003, Vancouver has lost over 850 units of low-income housing; during the same period, homelessness has increased from 1,000 to over 2,500. It is estimated by 2010, the number of homeless may be as high as 6,000!



Criminalization of the Poor: To 'clean out' the poor and undesirables, Olympic host cities routinely begin campaigns to criminalize the poor. In Vancouver, the city has launched Project Civil City and new by-laws to criminalize begging for money, sleeping outdoors, add more private security, etc.

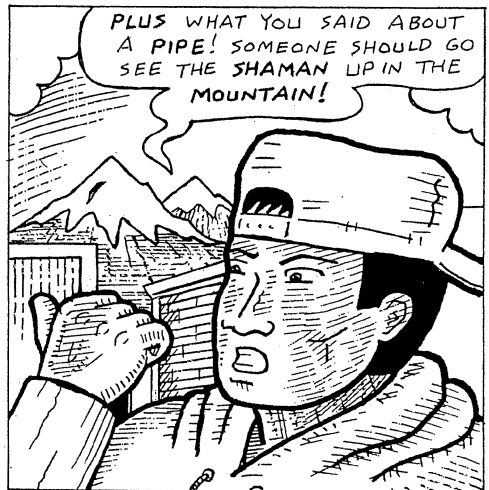

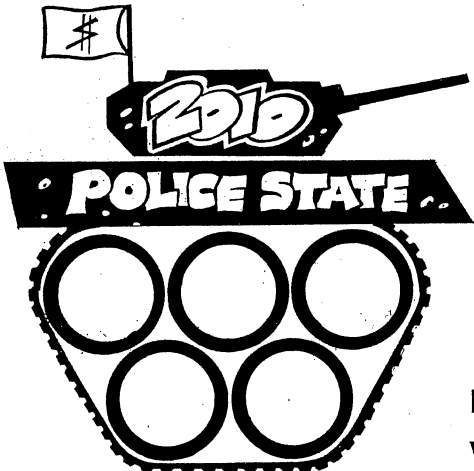
