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In the 1960s, Edward Sanders co-founded the groundbreaking rock band The Fugs, opened the Peace Eye Bookstore, and appeared on the cover of *Life* magazine, becoming a hero of the American counterculture. He is a classics scholar, pioneer in investigative poetics, inventor of musical instruments, publisher of *The Woodstock Journal*, and author of many books, including the best-selling Charles Manson exposé *The Family*, the ambitious, nine-volume project, *America: A History in Verse*, and the recently reissued American Book Award-winning collection, *Thirsting for Peace in a Raging Century*. He lives in Woodstock, New York.



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
