
About this factsheet

Privacy policy



There are rules about what Family Planning Victoria

- does with your **personal information**
- does **not** do with your personal information.



Some people call these rules a **privacy policy**.



Personal information

You might tell Family Planning Victoria personal information.

Examples of personal information are your

- name
- address
- date of birth.



We also keep health information.

For example, your

medical history



medication.

You can ask Family Planning Victoria what other personal information we keep.



Family Planning Victoria and your personal information



Family Planning Victoria collects your personal information.



The information is used to

 tell doctors and health professionals about your condition.



record how much money is owed to
Medicare and other doctors caring for you.

do medical research.
You will need to agree to this first.

help train new doctors and nurses.
You will need to agree to this first.



Do you have to give Family Planning Victoria your personal information?



No.



But we may **not** be able to help you with all of our services.

We keep your information safe



We keep your personal information in a safe place. For example, we

• put locks on filing cabinets



• have passwords on computers.



How can you see your personal information?

You need to do 4 things




1. Phone or email the Privacy Officer

 - Driver's licence
 - Passport



Important



Sometimes we must say you can **not** see

your personal information

• your child's personal information.



For example when,

• the law says we must say no



someone else asks for your information

• a doctor tells us it might hurt someone.



If we say no, we will tell you why.



Complaints

A complaint is when

• you are **not** happy

and

you tell someone the reason.



You can make a complaint about what Family Planning Victoria

- did with your personal information
- did **not** do with your personal information.
