Antiterrorist trial for 6 comrades from the 14th to the 22nd of may, 2012

Ivan, Bruno et Damien were arrested in january 2008. They were going to a demonstration in front of the detention center for foreigners of Vincennes (near Paris), with handmade smokebombs, some twisted nail sharpened on both ends to stop vehicles, that justice and medias take as a "nail bomb". Therefore, Ivan and Bruno were remanded in custody and Damien put on probation.

A few days later, Inès (*Isa) and Frank (*Farid) were arrested after customs control at Vierzon (center of France) in possession of a book about sabotage techniques, a map of a juvenile prison, and some chlorate. Antiterrorism seized upon the case. The cops claimed that Ines' DNA could match with one of the 5 DNA's traces found on an incendiary under a police car during the presidential elections of 2007.

Soon, both cases were joined together, set up by the same anti-terrorist judges. The cops wanted to put a name on the DNA's traces found under the police car. So, they looked inside the entourage of the people arrested and also the people on file "to be members" of the so-called "anarcho-autonome" movement. Javier (*Juan), Inès' brother, then Damien (who had been arrested with Ivan and Bruno), are put in jail for several months. Police said that their DNA could match.

More over, Javier has been charged for several incendiary sabotages on some railway electric system, that stopped the traffic during the social movement against the CPE in 2006. Again, the evidence would be DNA traces.

Ines, Javier, Damien, Ivan, Frank and Bruno spent from 5 to 13 months in custody. Today, they still are on probation until the trial.
