The Nebraska 2 were charged and convicted of the murder of Omaha Police Officer Larry Minard. Minard died when a suitcase containing dynamite exploded in a North Omaha home in 1970. Poindexter and Rice were framed for their participation in the Black Panther Party. The Omaha Police withheld evidence at trial. The two had been targeted by ColntelPro which operated against and infiltrated activist groups, including the Omaha Black Panthers. The state's parole board have recommended the men for release, but they continue to be caged.
