A SHORTER WORK DAY.

After an investigation which extended over many weeks, a committee of experient engineers reported through the columns of "Page's Engineering Weekly," which is a journal of the master class, that "the work would be improved, and the health of the worker better served by shorter shifts. Many griss at work in the munition factories worked well, but the best of them had a limit, and they were fast reaching that limit. It has taken the Government 18 months to find out that excessive labor dispinishes the output and impair the health of the workers. The point has been pressed home, that instead of lengthening the hours they must be shortened."

The above is not a statement by a labor demagogue, but the report of experts who have made a systematic investigation into the condition of the workers in the engineering shops in England.

Charles P. Steinmetz, chief engineer of the General Electric Company, U.S.A., has stated: "It is true that working class efficiency increases with a shortening of the hours.
