Topic: Glyphosate

Surveytext:

Glyphosate is a chemical found in many pesticides used widely across Europe (for example, "Roundup" from Monsanto). The International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) of the World Health Organization (WHO) has classified glyphosate as probably cancer-causing to humans. The European Food Safety Authority (EFSA), in contrast, has concluded that glyphosate poses no cancer risk to humans.

The European Union is currently debating the reapproval of the use of glyphosate for pesticides. In your opinion, what should the EU decide?
