

Let none who hope in you be *put to* **shame**; * but shamed are those who wantonly *break* **faith**.


2. O LORD, make me *know your* ways. * Teach me *your* paths.

 - For the oppressed, the LORD will be *a* **strong**hold, * a stronghold in times of *distress*.


3. Have mercy on me, O LORD; †

from the violent attack *of the* wicked.


My foes encircle me with deadly intent.*
